The Harpy

You can resize the files if you want a smaller (or larger) sized miniatures in your game, these files are good to 28-32mm miniatures without changes. The finished model with the base and wings will be 10 cm high. Reduce the size with 10% to get a more accurate sized model (it will be harder to print on FDM printers). Use supports to the body and wings parts, rotate the parts to find the perfect position you desire for printing.

We have printed this models at 100 (wings and base) and 50 (body) micron layer height, 15 percent infill and 195C with PLA, with a 0.2 mm nozzle. These numbers may vary based on your printer and the material you use.

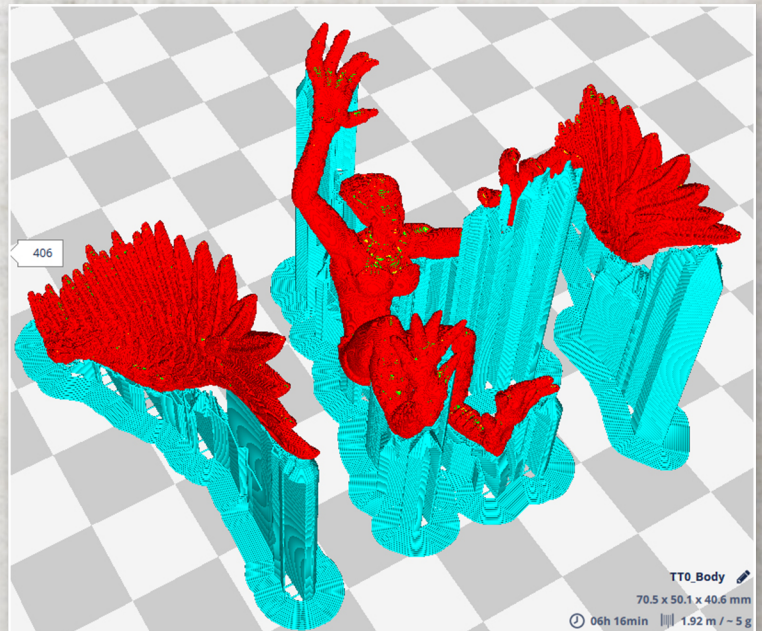
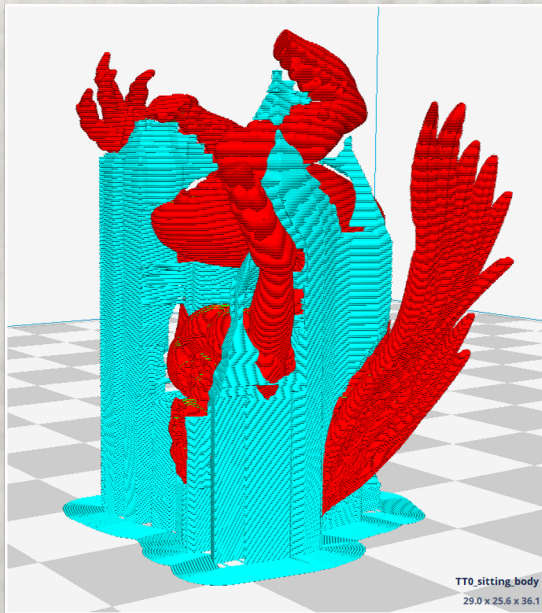


Attacking



You can print out the bases without supports.

Rotate and align the other parts to find the best angle to print them with support. Use brim around the objects.



You can set the overhang angle to 70 at this place to print it with less supports and make it easily removable.
