

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

These are optional pieces for use with the West Gate papercraft model from Dave Graffam Models (available from www.DavesGames.net). To create these pieces, print this page on 1 sheet of cardstock (100# cardstock recommended). You'll also need scissors, a hobby knife and glue. Follow the trimming guides at right. **Cut along the black lines with scissors or a hobby knife.** *Score with a hobby knife and fold back along the red lines.* *Score on the back of the sheet and fold forward along the green lines.* Fold back along the red lines and glue the pieces together so that they become two-sided pieces. The "hinge" flaps should be folded forward, and then glued in place to the main West Gate model wherever appropriate. Optionally, you can finish these pieces by using a fine-line black marker to fill in the white edges.

USING THE TEXTURE LAYERS

This PDF file contains layers that you can make visible or invisible. To make changes, open the Layers menu and expand the file name to reveal the selection of layers. Some of them will be visible; others will be invisible. Click on the 'eye' icon to change a layer's visibility. Choose your surface textures and add or remove external features. When you're happy with your design, just print it off.
