


Note: Before proceeding with these instructions, please read the beginners guide PDF document included with this model which includes a complete list of necessary materials to construct this model. We recommend that you browse all the way through this set of instructions before beginning. DRAGON FOUNTAIN



1: Cut and test fold the dragon pieces as shown.




2: Fold the wings and dragon head in half and glue, being careful not to glue together the tabs at the bottom (fold them away from each other before applying glue.) Allow to fully dry before attempting to cut out the excess white areas.



3: Cut away the excess card stock. We recommend not trying to cut completely though in one pass, but rather going over the line to be cut 2-3 times as this will greatly improve accuracy.



4: Cut and score the main pedestal as shown. Make sure you cut out the four thin slits that the water will glue into later.



5: Fold the glue tabs inward. It will help to use a straight edge for the tabs that are over the rectangular water openings as the paper will want to fold where they are and not the tab unless a straight edge is butted up to the fold edge.



6: Fold into a ring and glue as shown.




7: Begin gluing the top piece by gluing a single tab and allowing to dry,




8: Glue the tab that is opposite of the first tab glued and allow to dry. You can then glue the remaining six tabs.



9: Cutout the four water pieces and test fold.




10: Insert them into the pedestal and glue to the interior.




11: Finish gluing all four pieces and allow to fully dry before proceeding.




12: Use a round marker body or similar shape to gently curve the water pieces so they do not have any kinks in them. An optional bottom piece (blank white piece) is included, but this isn't really necessary (we elected not to use it for this build.)




13: Both of the lower two tiers of the fountain assemble in exactly the same way, they are just different diameters. Cut, score and test fold the side walls as shown.




14: Glue into a ring and allow to fully dry before proceeding.



15: As with the pedestal, glue one tab to the top cover piece and allow to dry.




16: Glue the opposite tab and allow to dry. Proceed to glue remaining six tabs.



17: Glue the top pedestal to the middle tier as shown. Glue the pedestal first and allow to fully dry before attempting to glue the water pieces.



18: You need to apply pressure while it dries to make sure it is completely flush with the middle tier top section.



19: Glue the water section bases to the top of the middle tier as shown.



20: Glue the dragon head into place first.



21: Glue the dragon wings into place.



22: Glue into bottom tier of the fountain to the middle tier. The bottom tier assembles exactly the same as the middle tier except that it does require the blank bottom piece to be glued for stability.

CART & STOCKS



1: Cut, score and test fold the cart model as depicted above.



2: Glue the side tabs and allow to dry. The stocks simply fold and glue in half, with the lower tabs folded outward.




MARKET STALL




1: Cut and score the stall pieces as shown.




2: Test fold the stall table as shown above.



3: Glue the side tabs as shown above. Finish by gluing the rear flap into place.




4: Fold and glue the canopy into a box shape as shown above.




5: Fold the support beams into tubes and glue. You need four of these per stall.



6: Cut and test fold the rear stall wall.




7: Fold rear stall wall in half and glue.



8: Begin gluing the four posts to the canopy as shown above. DO NOT shove them up to the top of the canopy, but rather align them around the bottom edge using the white glue areas to position them accurately.



9: Allow all four to fully dry before turning over.



10: Glue the rear wall to the rear two posts (either in front of them or behind- your choice.)



11: Completed market stall.
