



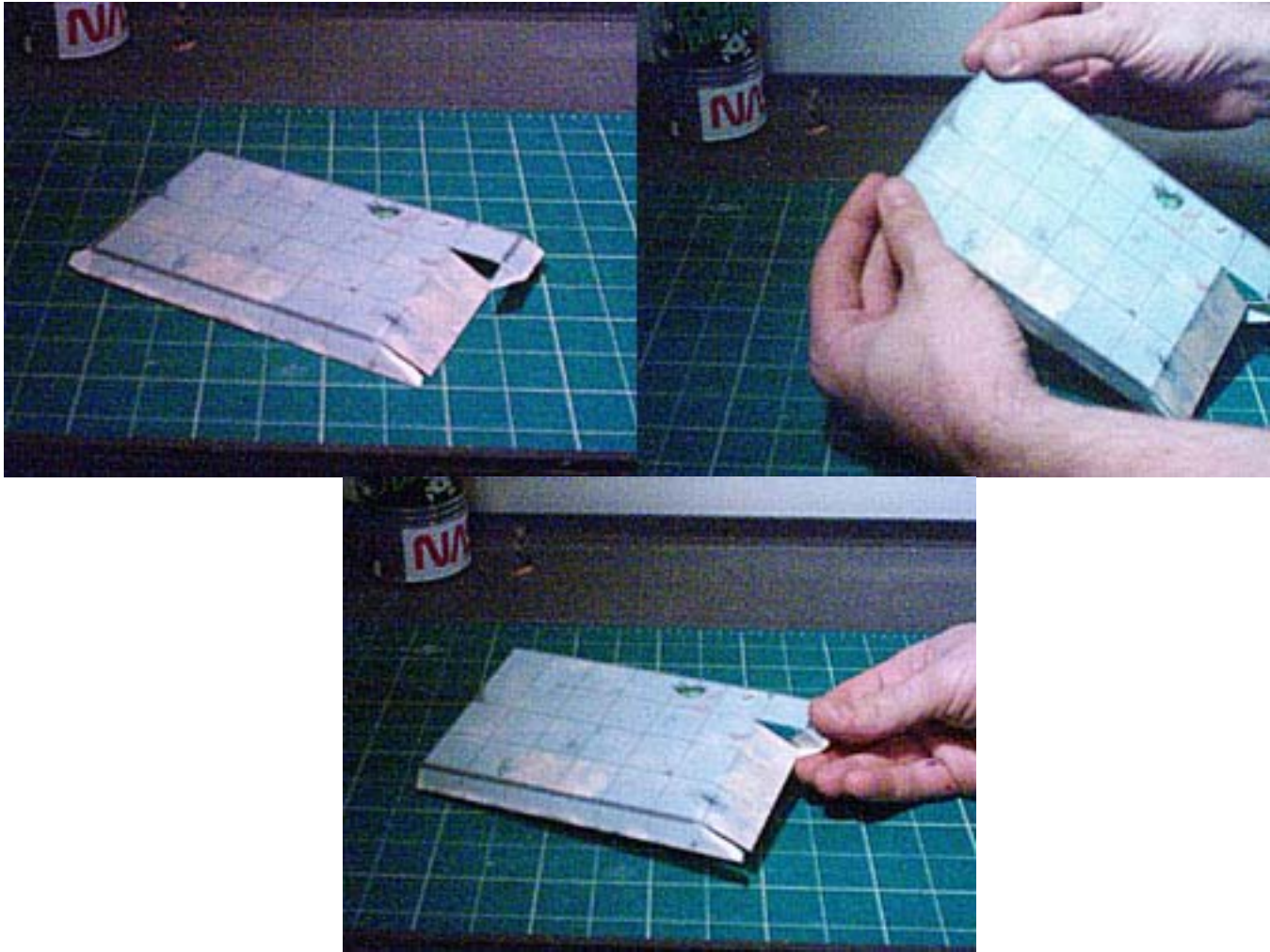
MODEL TYPE:	ARENA RISERS
DIFFICULTY:	2 out of 5
APPROX BUILD TIME:	Quick - 5 to 10 minutes <i>(Time may vary depending on skill level)</i>
DUPLICATIONS <i>(Suggested)</i> :	1 to 2 copies <i>(optimal)</i>
EDGING COLOR:	Grey or Black felt <i>(What is “Edging”?</i> <i>Please refer to the included “Beginners Guide”.</i>

This riser can be used to give the arena a bit of variety, use the “ruined” columns likewise. Park them on top of the riser or wherever you need a bit of scenery, they would make a semi-authentic addition to the “Spina” wall. If you feel the riser needs more support, cut and glue the “Riser Support” and attach onto the underside. The Wizard Circle riser is very basic and I have not included step-by step instructions. Cut, fold and glue.



STEP 1:

Cut and score as shown. Apply glue to all tabs and fold into a box shape. To form the ramp, fold the reverse tab and tuck under. Hold until dry.



STEP 2:

Cut and score as shown. To form the columns, glue the long tab and fold over. Pop it back into a box shape and glue the end tabs. Tuck them in and hold until dry. Repeat with all the pieces.



STEP 3:

Apply a dot of glue to an end of the completed columns and press onto the base. Put another dot of glue atop the columns and press the top section down. Hold until dry.
