






**TABLES, CHAIRS, FIRE PODIUMS**





**Difficulty Rating (Out of 10): 5** (None of the models on this sheet are particularly difficult to build but one sheet contains more cuts than the average model set.)

**Recommended Duplications: 1-2** (Once again this is all dependent on how complicated you want your dungeon design to be. How many tables, chairs and torches do you require? One sheet contains two tables, four chairs and two podium torches. The choice is yours!)

**Steps:**

- Cut and score where marked. Cut straight through the black cut lines to separate individual items.
- The table and chair follow the same basic pattern. Fold these models along their score lines and you will have a better understanding of their construction. Fold the top chair section down to create a sandwich that will form the chairs backrest.
- Glue this backrest sandwich together. Glue the remaining flaps along the beige tabs (glue tabs) on both the table and chair sets. Refer to photos for reference.
- The fire podium is essentially the same process. Fold along the score lines and glue

tab in place. Sandwich the fire section together. Take the fire section and glue its tabs to the bowl where marked. Glue the bowl to the top of the podium.
