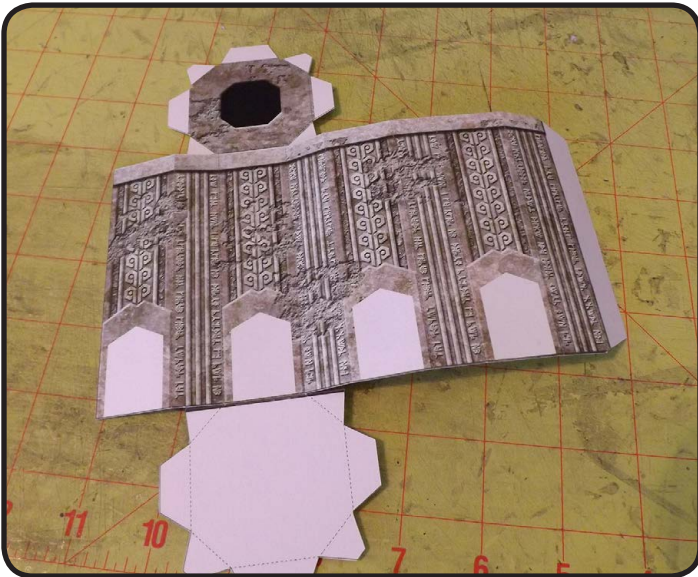

## DUNGEONS OF THE MOUNTAIN KING

Before proceeding with this document, make sure you have read the beginners guide to card modeling included with this model set. Also, review all of your layer options before printing, there are several ways you can design your tower!

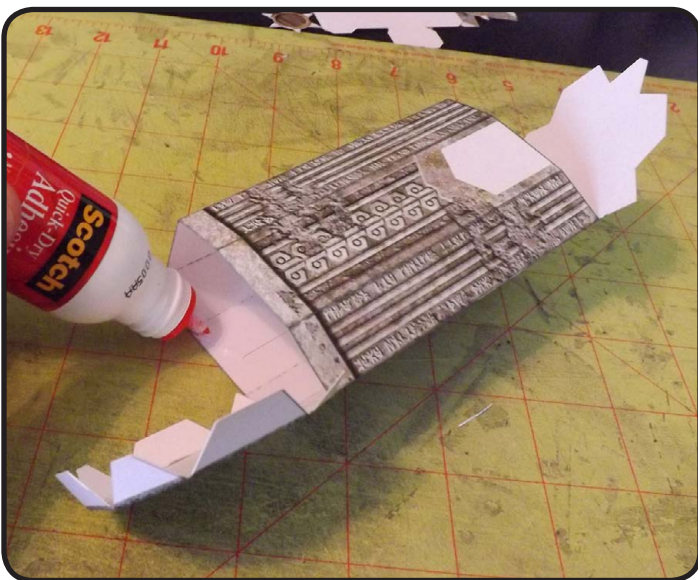
### FORGE ROOM



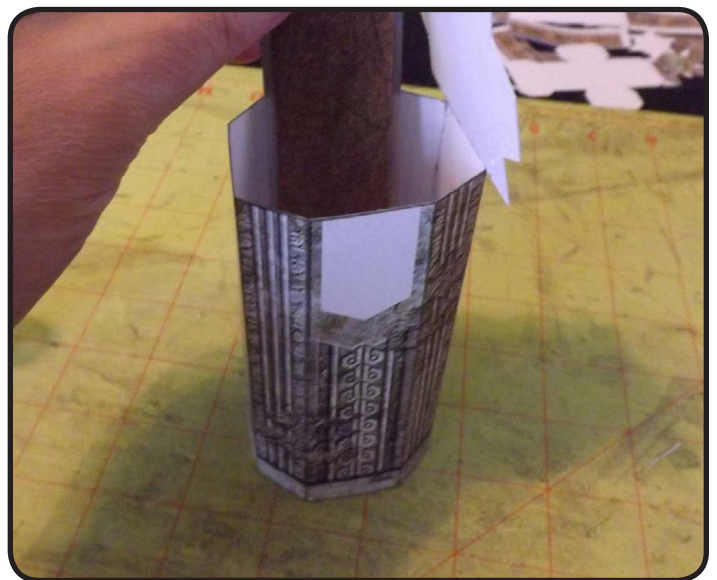
1: Cut and score the forge pieces and edge with a marker before proceeding.



2: Glue the long side seam first.



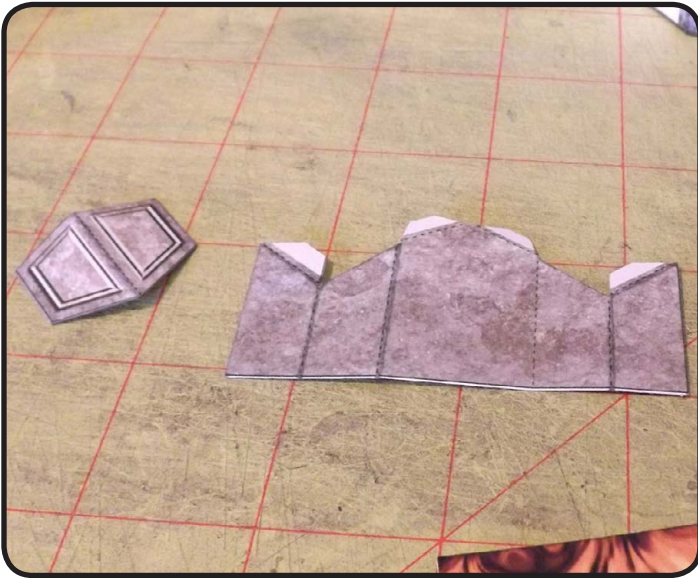
3: When gluing the end flaps, it is simpler to apply the glue to the inside edge of the walls instead of the glue tabs (shown above.)



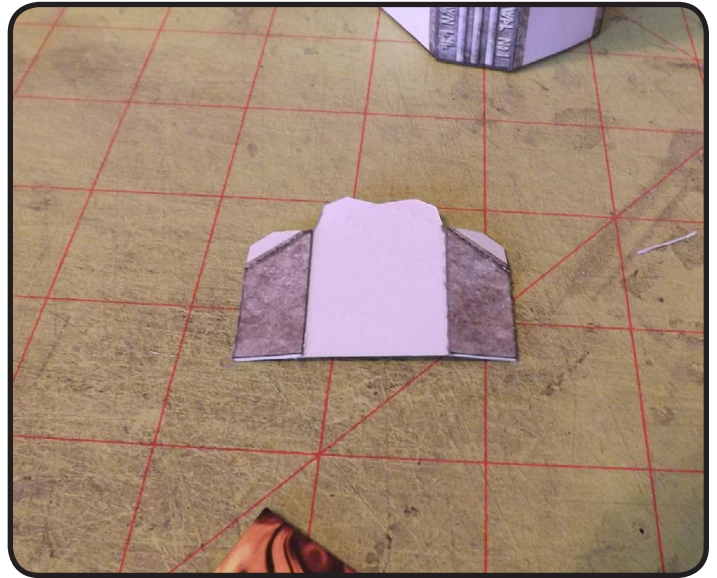
4: Glue the top flap first, turning the model upside down to allow access to the interior of the model to apply pressure to the glue tabs from within as shown.



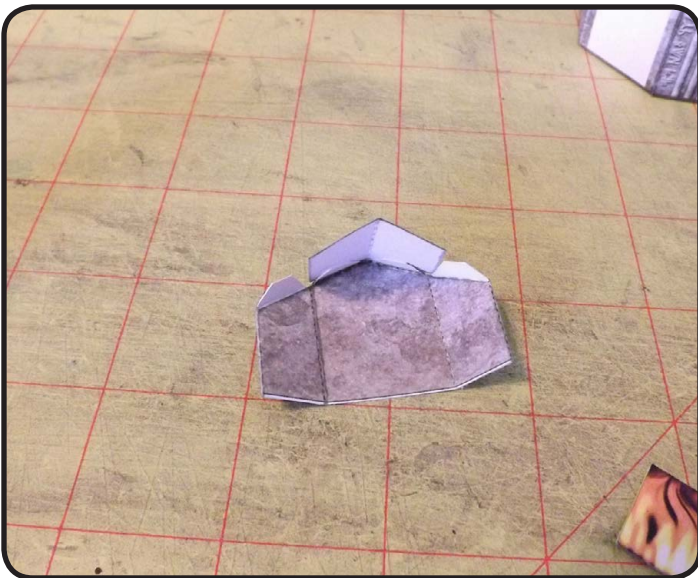

5: Cut out and score each of the fireplace pieces.



6: Glue the side flaps inward as depicted above.



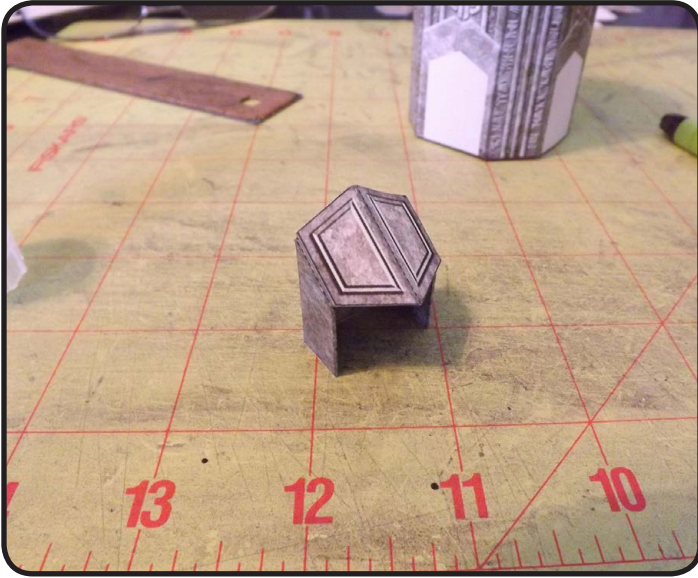
7: Glue the top section to the top two tabs first.



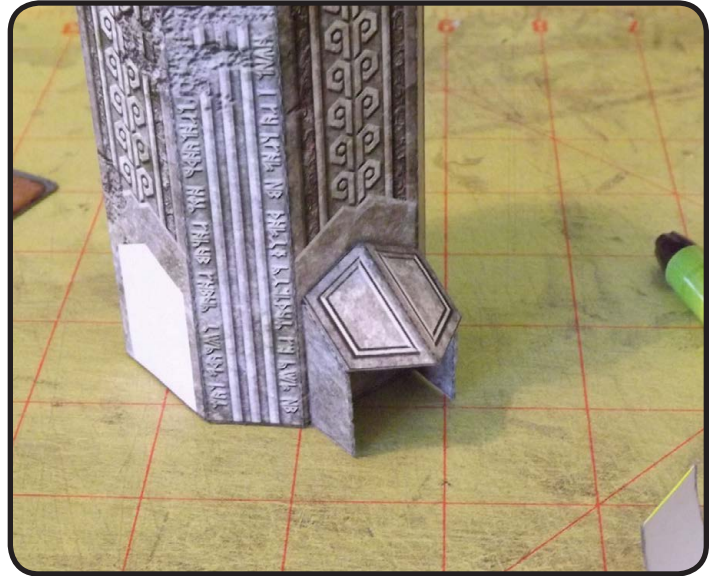
8: The end with the shallower angle to the peak goes to the rear.



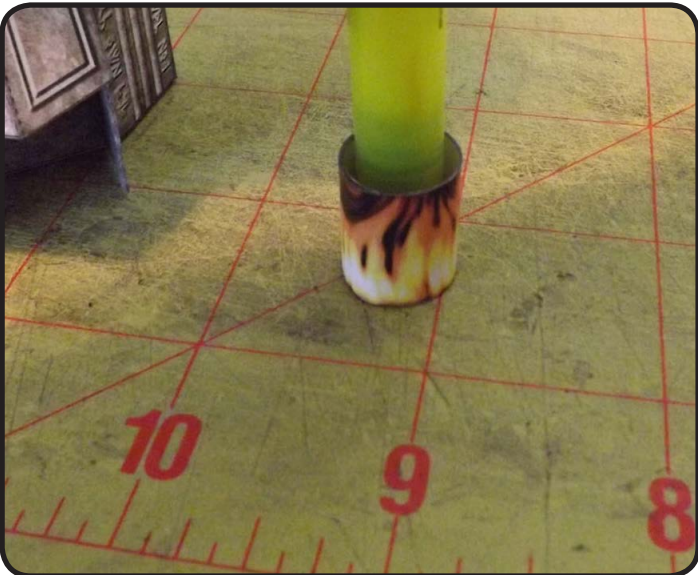

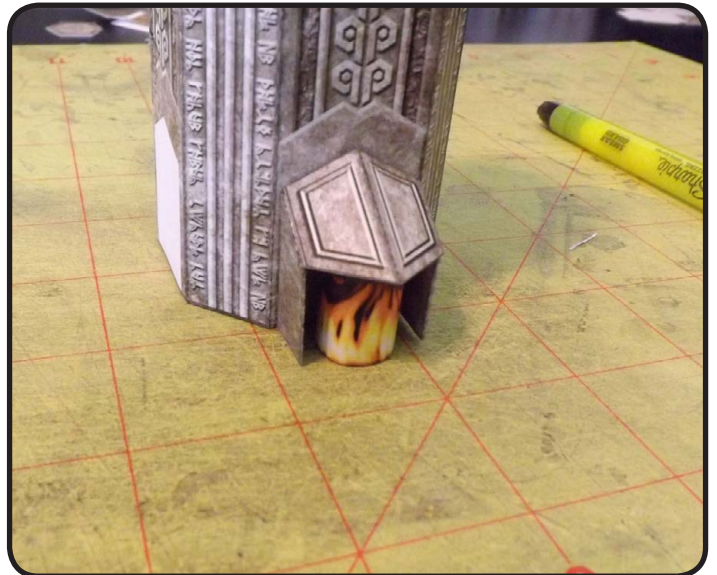
9: Finish by gluing the side tabs.



10: Glue to the main pillar. Repeat for the other three sides.



11: Use a marker or other round object to curve the fire piece around when you glue it.



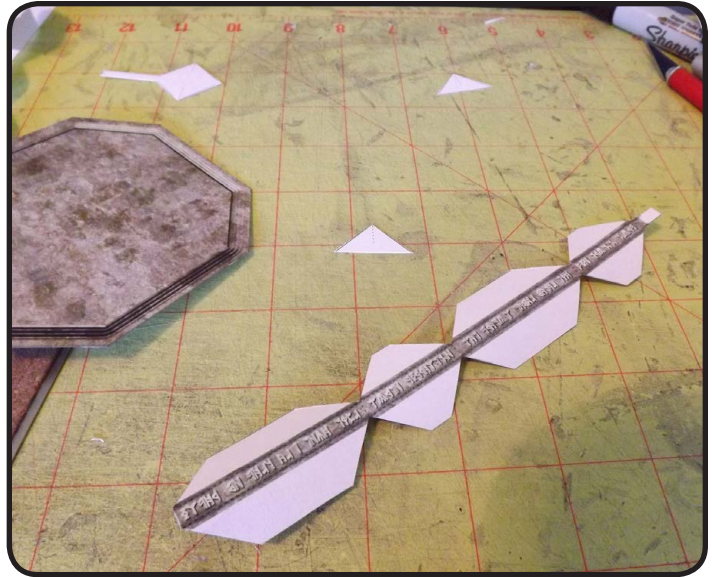
12: Insert the fire piece as shown.



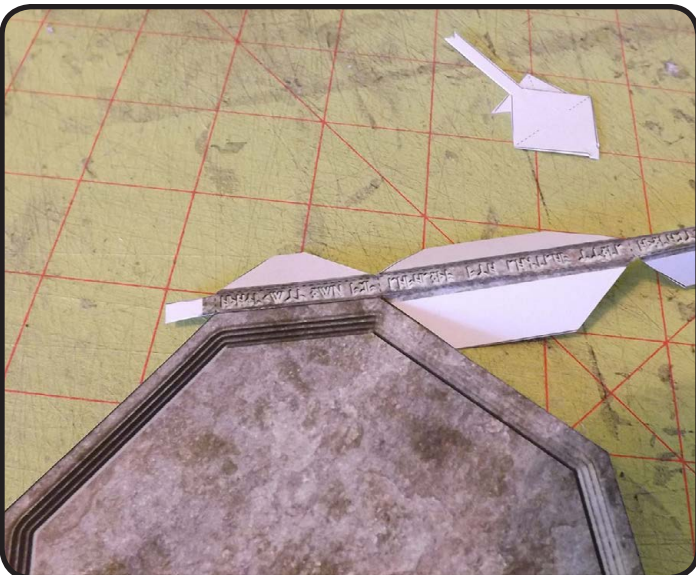

14: Cut and score the pieces for the dais.



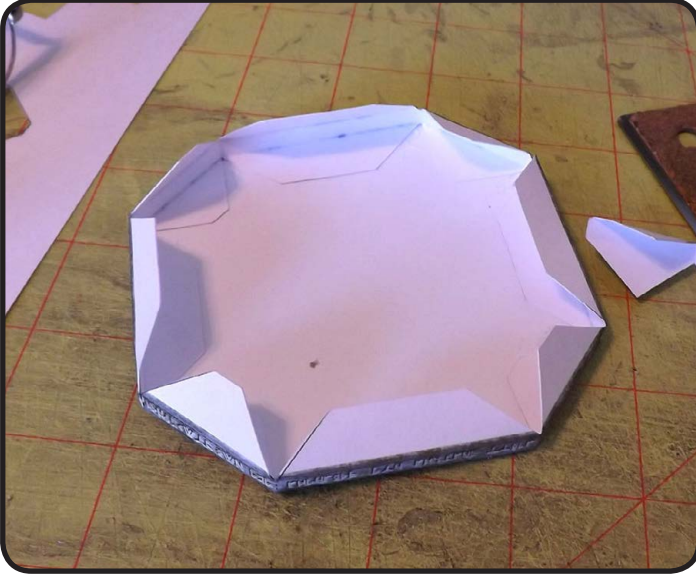
15: Begin by gluing one edge strip to the main piece.



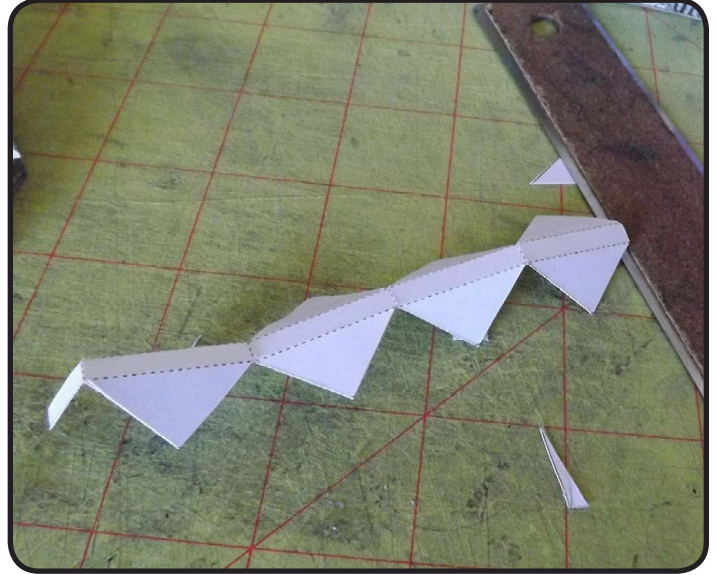
16: Continue gluing around the perimeter.



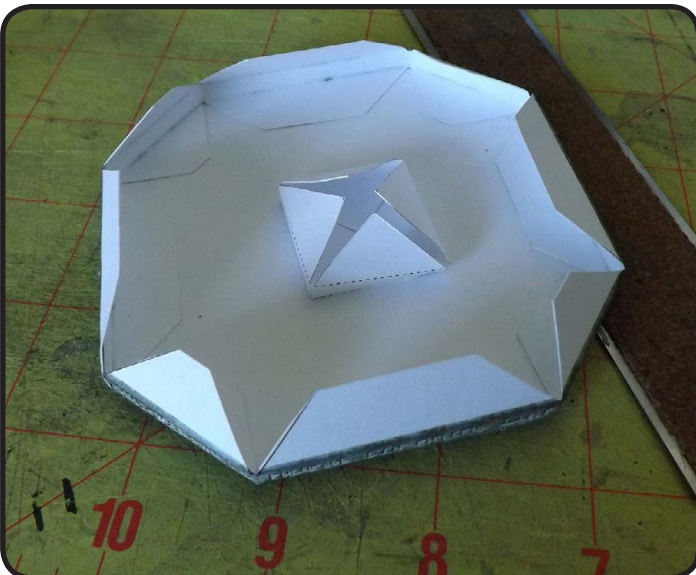

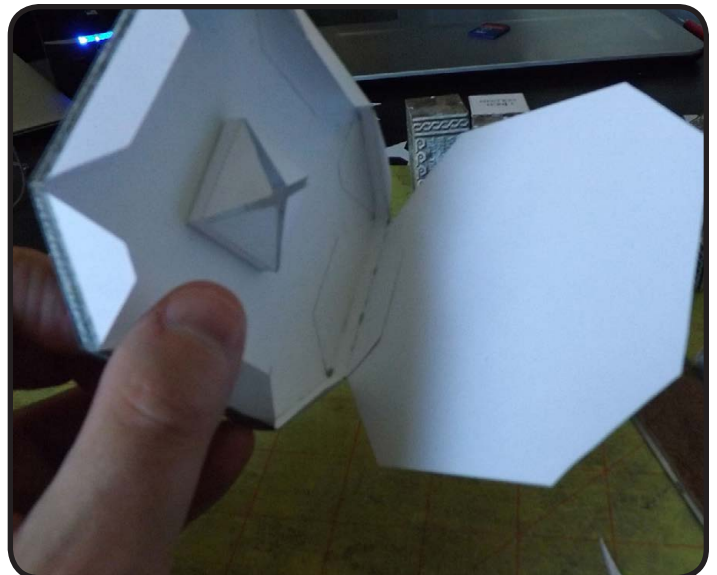
17: Finish by gluing the second side strip.



18: Cut and score the interior brace.



19: Glue the interior brace into place as shown above.



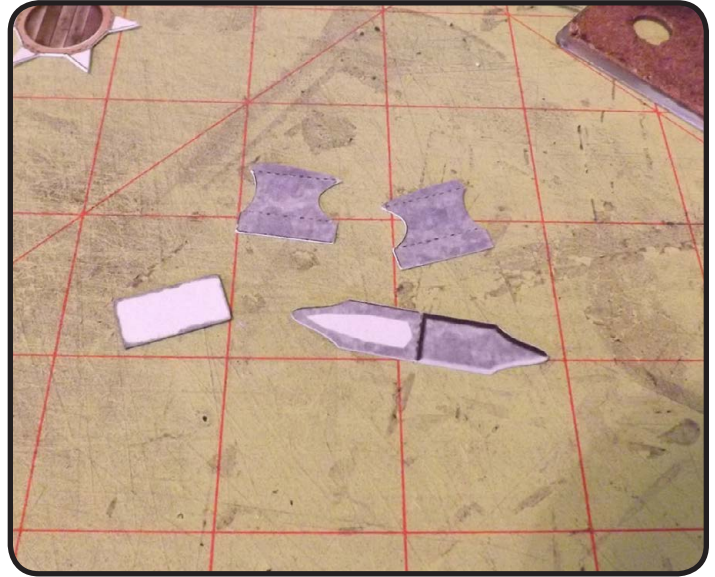
20: Glue one edge of the bottom piece in place.



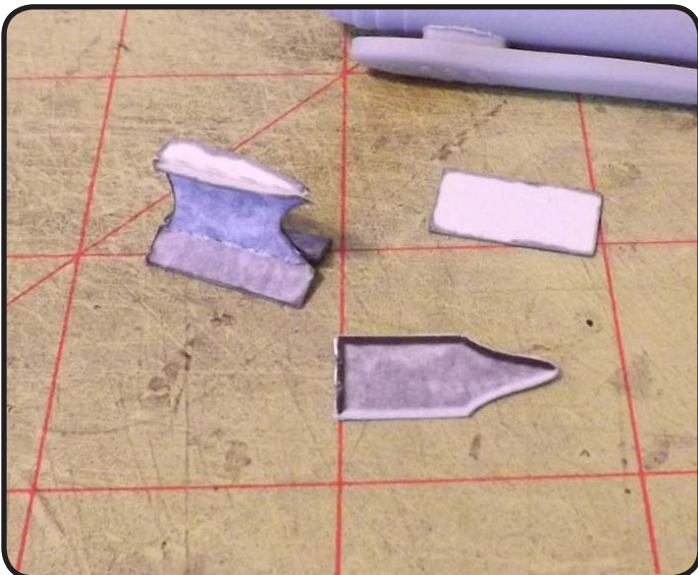

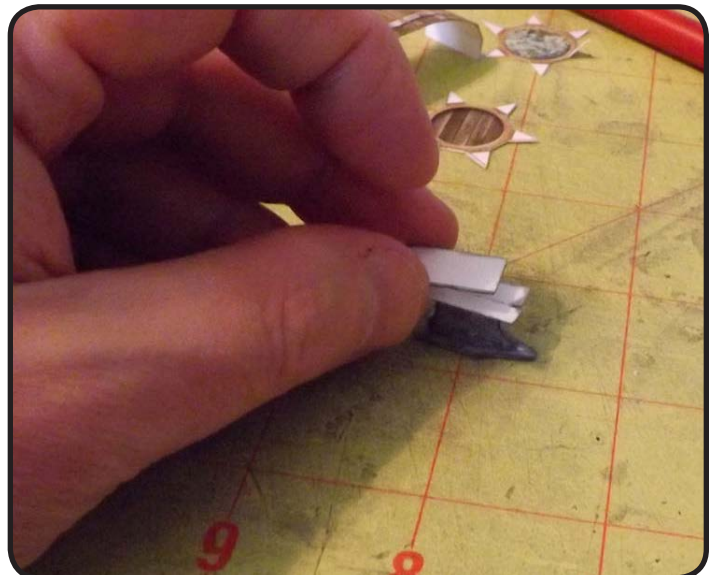
21: The finished dais.



22: Cut and score the four anvil pieces. You will probably be better not to cut apart the two side pieces (cut them as one piece) and leave them to be glued in half before trimming away the excess white areas.



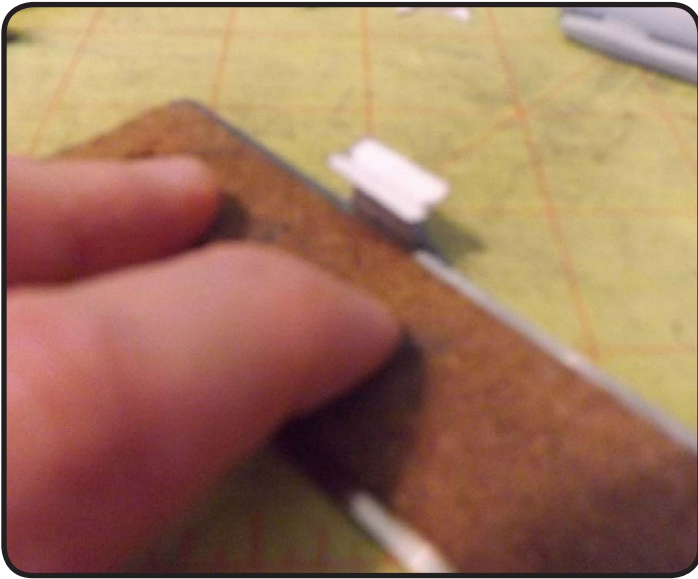
23: Glue the side pieces together, making sure the upper and lower tabs aren't glued together.



24: Glue the bottom to the underside of the side section.

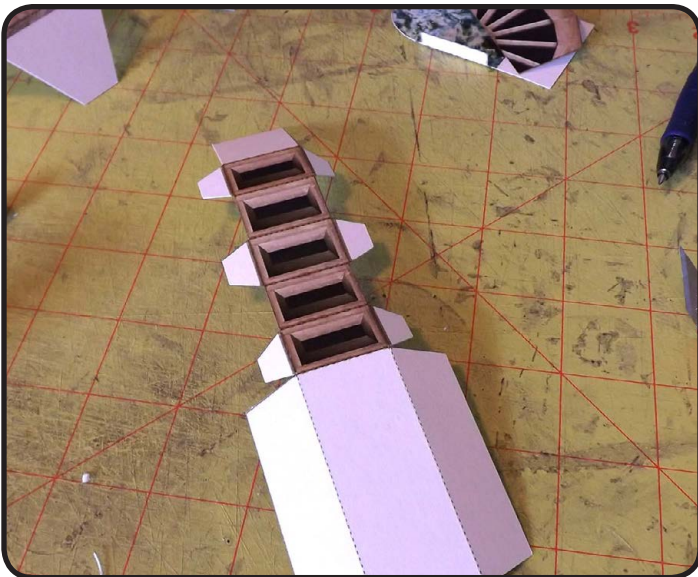


25: You can use a ruler to apply pressure to the tabs gluing to the bottom piece as they dry.



26: Finish by gluing the top piece in place.

## TIP HAMMERS



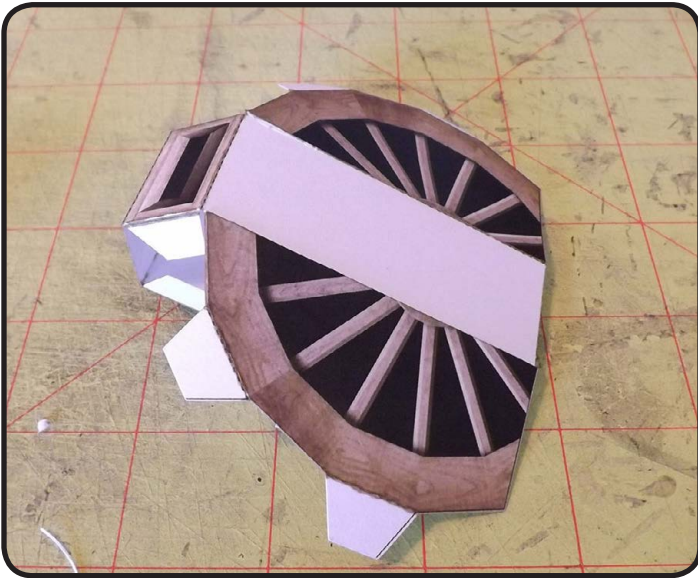
1: Cut and score the pieces for the water wheel.



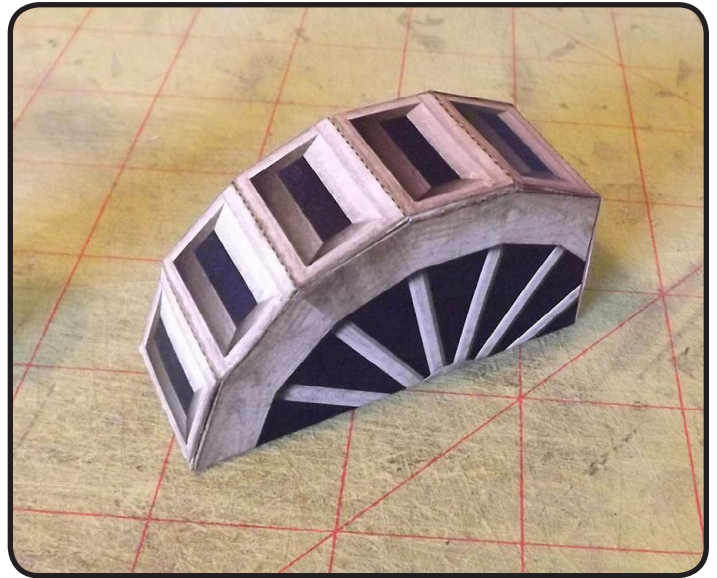
2: Fold over and glue the ends of the main piece together.



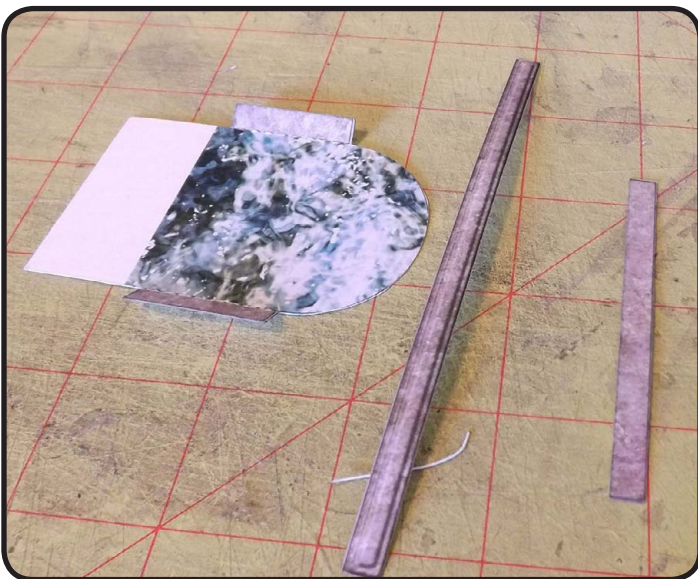

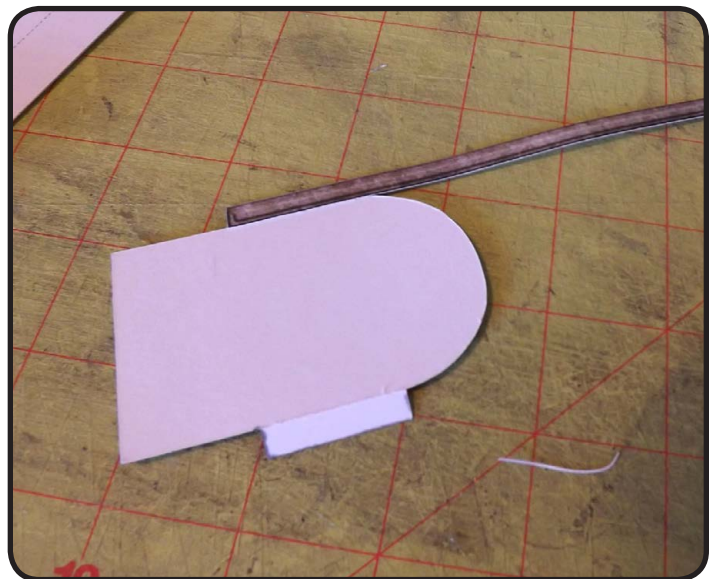
3: Glue the two side sections to the center piece rear tabs.



4: Finish by gluing the remaining tabs of the side sections to the main piece.



5: Cut and score....



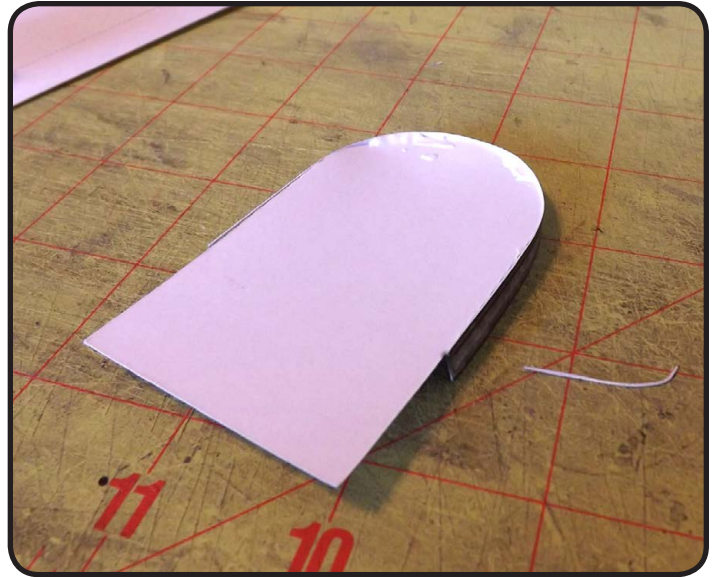
6: Glue the edge strip to the bottom piece as shown above.



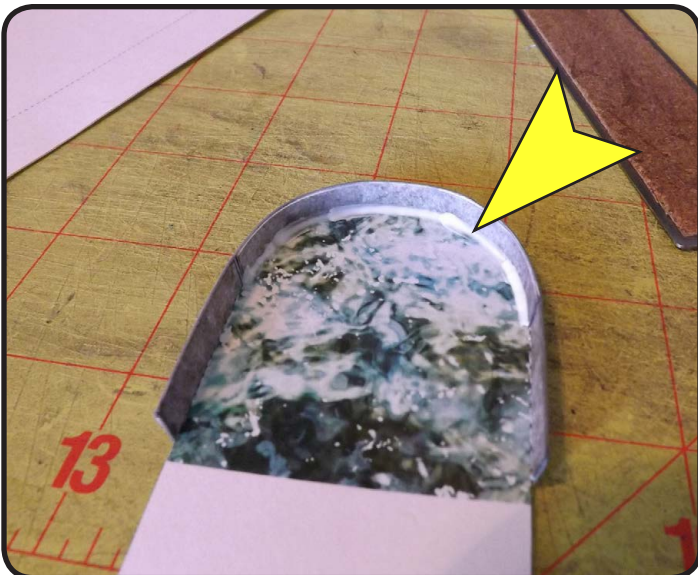

7: Glue the edge strip to both sides, making sure it is snug against the curve of the bottom piece.



8: Apply white glue around the bottom edge as shown.



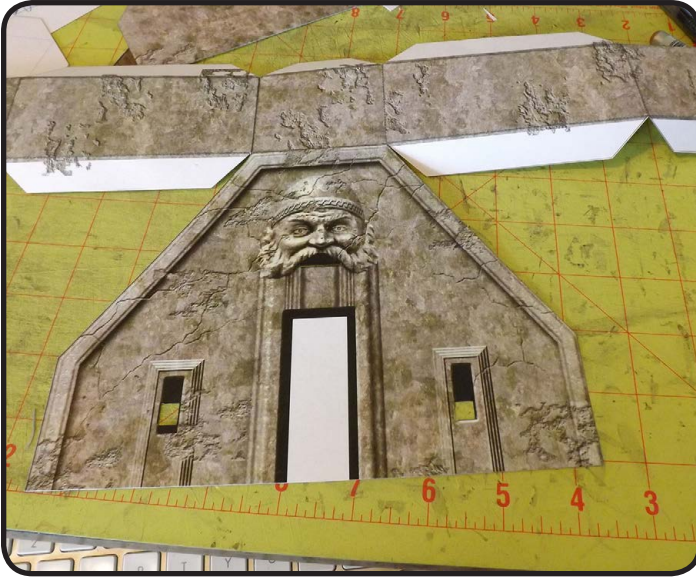
9: Push the lower piece down so it is flush with the lower edge of the edge strip, apply a little bead of white glue around the lower edge.



10: Begin the main tip hammer wall model by gluing the side sections to the top section as shown above.

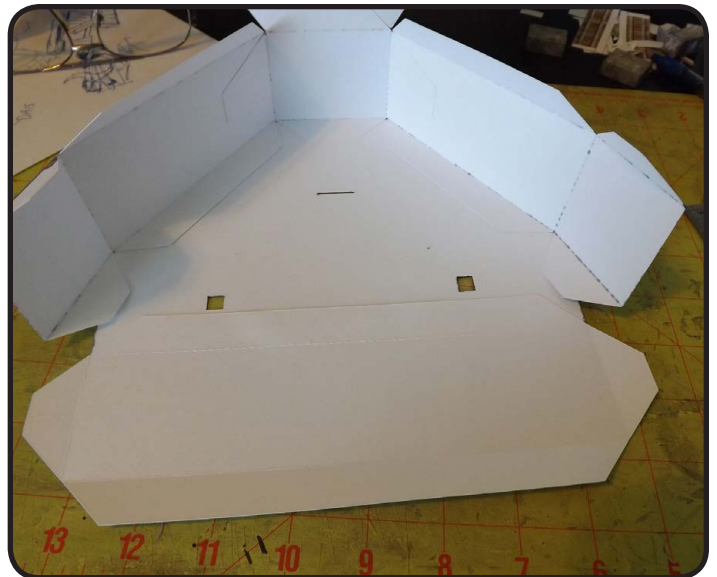
11: Glue the front side to the top strip.



12: Glue the bottom side to the lower edge of the front section.



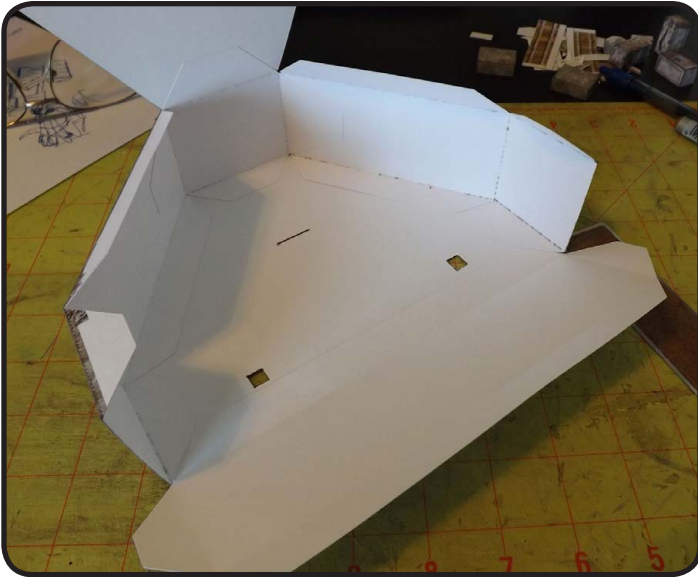
13: Glue the rear side to the top strip.



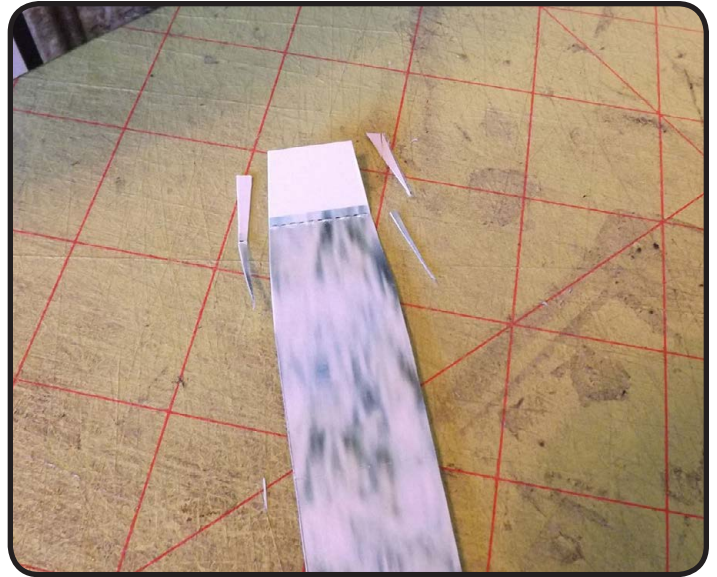
14: Begin gluing the side strip to the FRONT side as depicted above. Work slowly, one tab at a time, starting with the two tabs closest to the top.



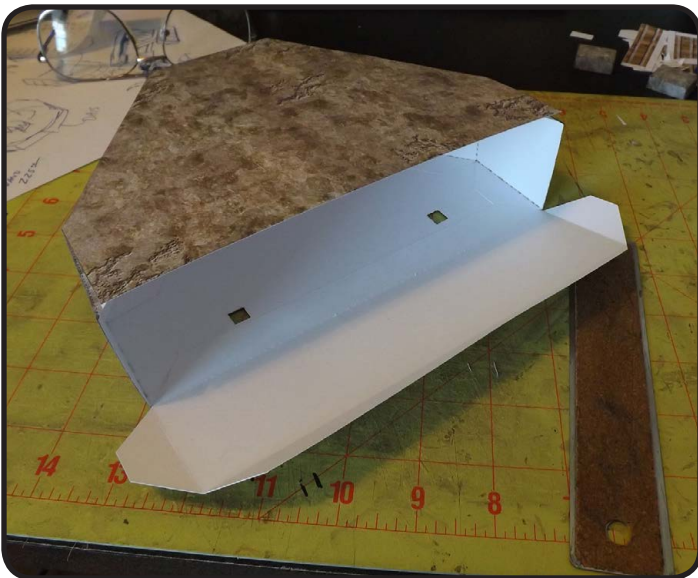

15: Next glue the lower side tabs to the front side.



16: While the main piece is drying, this is a good time to cut out the water piece. Cut a slight taper in the upper section as shown.



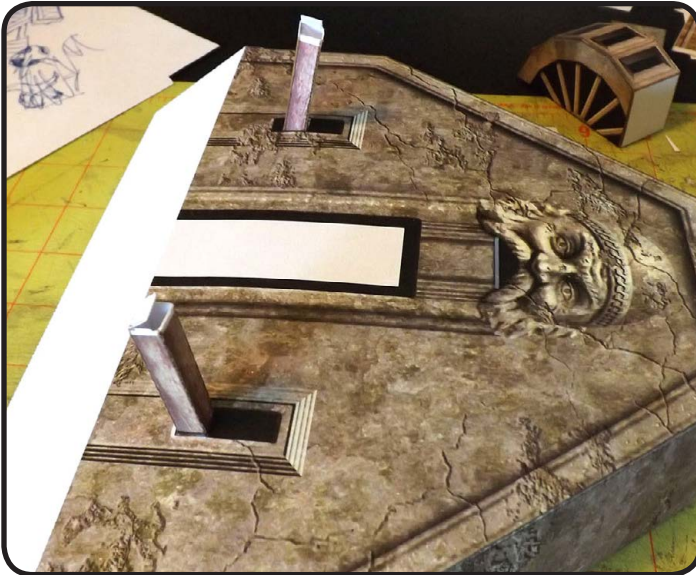
17: Next glue the rear face to the side edges.



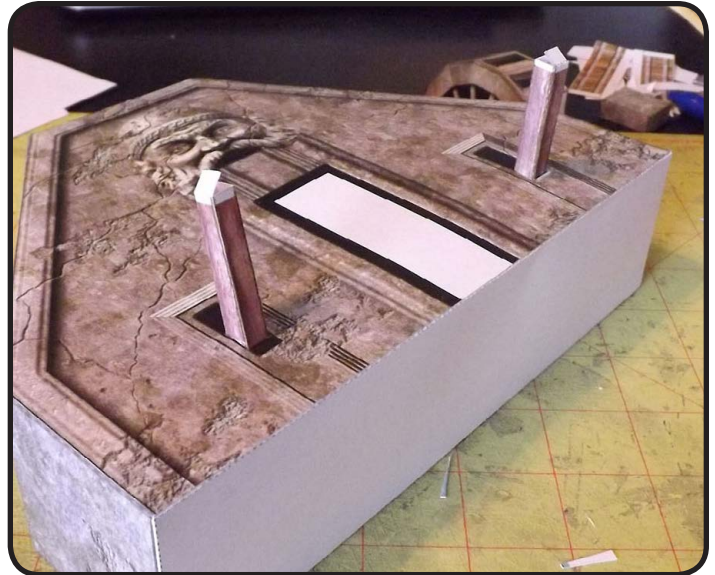
18: Construct the hammer pieces as depicted above.

19: Insert the hammer shafts through the interior of the main wall model through their respective holes. Note which side the angled shaft goes through (it has black under the hole for the shaft.)



20: Glue the bottom flap in place.



21: Glue the hammer heads on to the shafts, and the water base and water wheel in place as shown above.

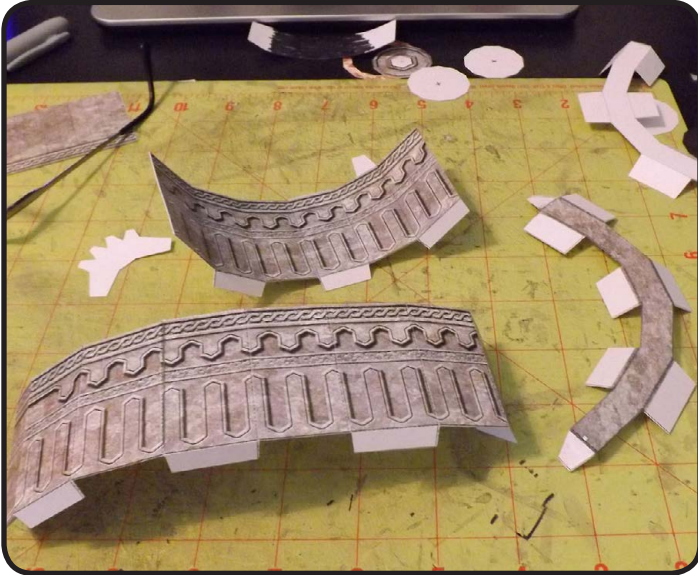


22: The water strip can be fitted in place without any glue so it can be removed and replaced as desired. Note how we have put a double curve into it by gently wrapping around the glue bottle in two areas.



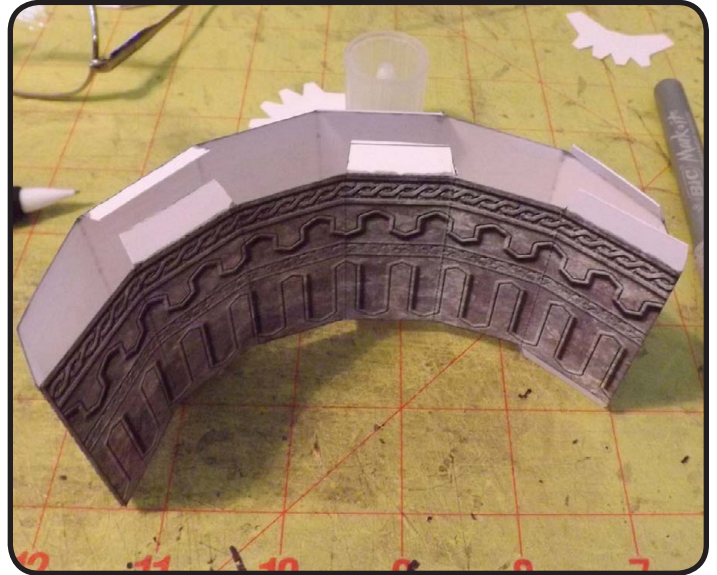

### WALLS

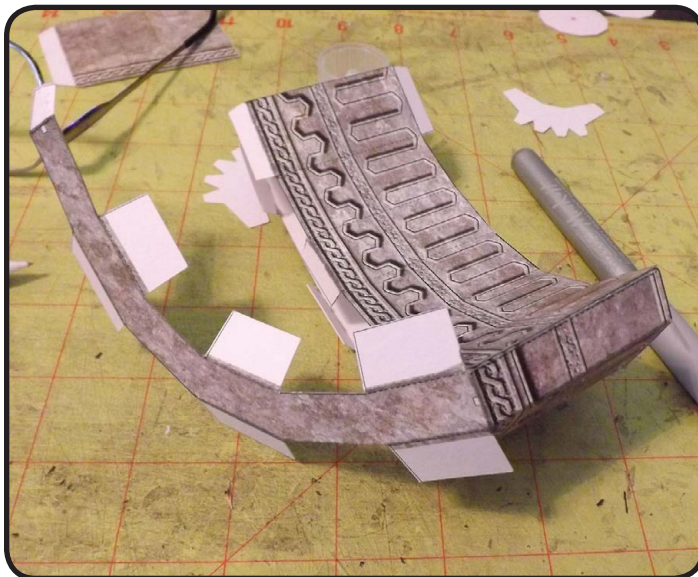


1: Whoever guessed “Cut, score and test fold” wins...

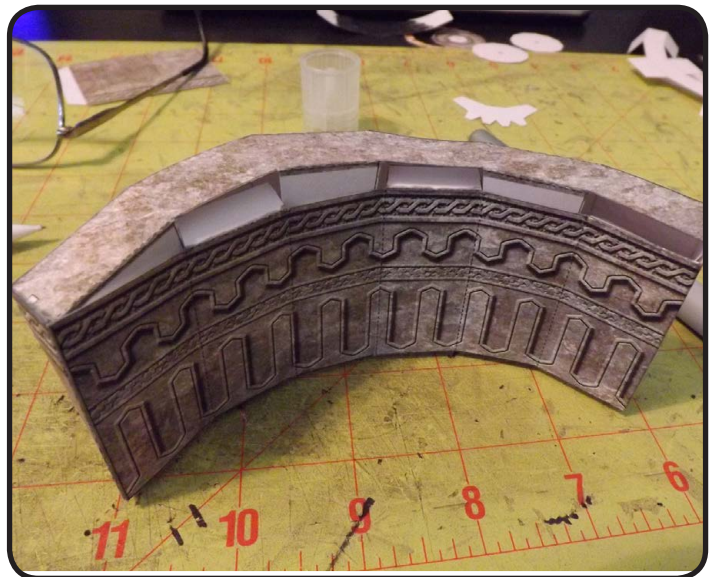
...absolutely nothing. :P



2: Bend into a curved shape and glue the ends of the two side wall pieces together.



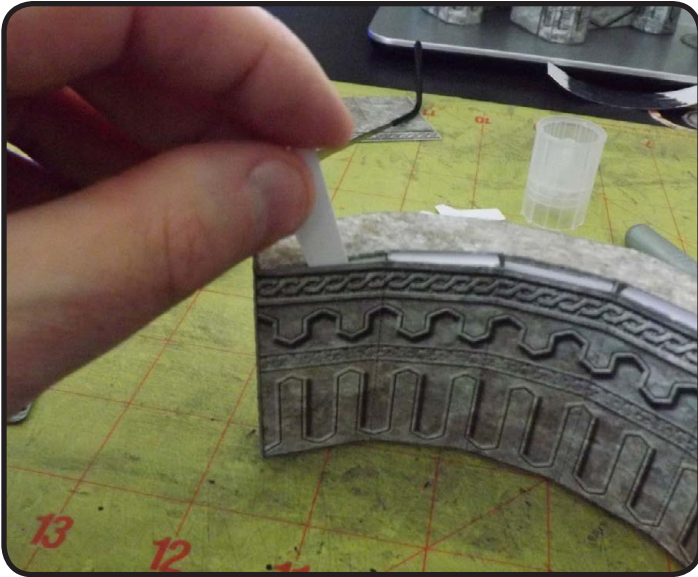
3: Glue one tab of the top piece as shown. Once dry, fold and glue into place.



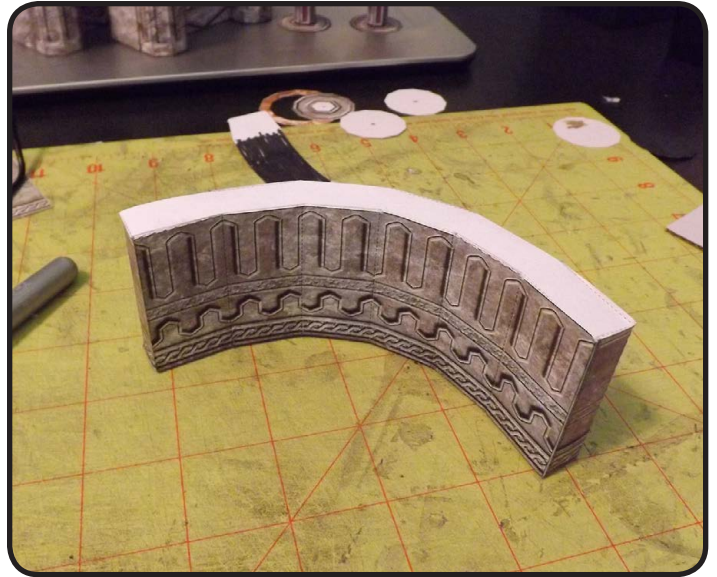
4: Glue the top piece into position.

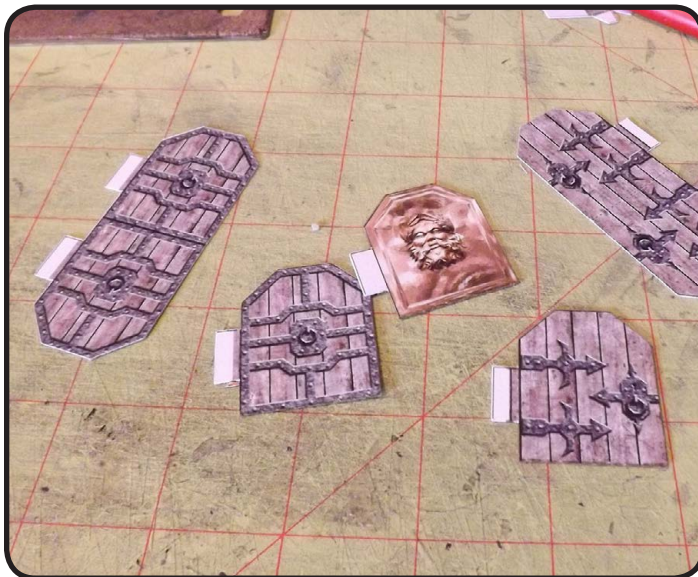


5: It is very easy to use a scrap of paper to insert glue into tight spaces.



6: Glue the bottom piece into place.

## DOORS



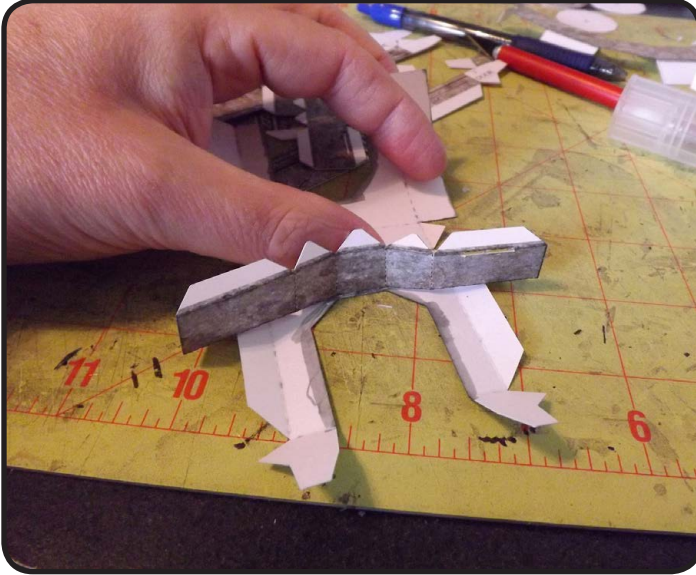
1: The doors simply fold and glue in half.



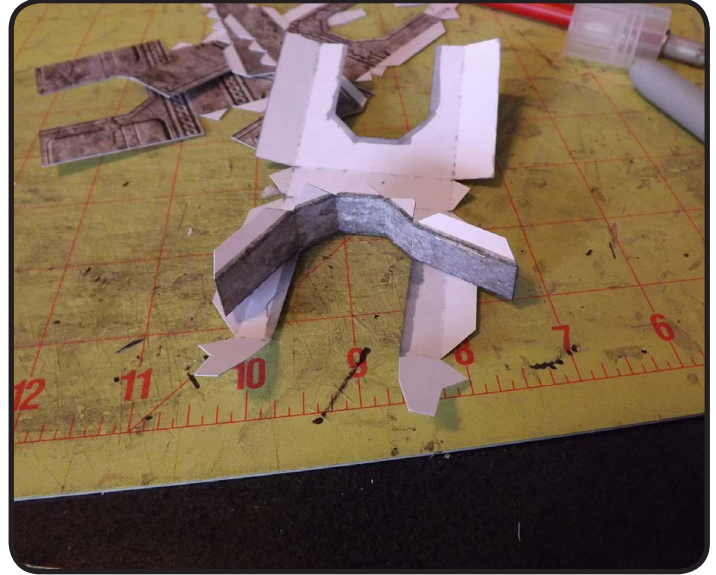
2: Cut and score the two main pieces for the doorway.



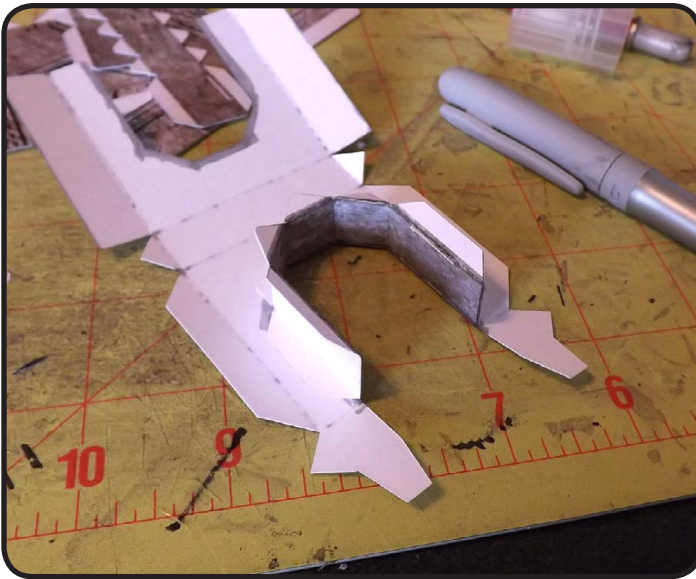

3: Glue the middle of the interior strip to the top of the door opening. Note that the interior edge of the door opening has been colored gray, just in case of any misalignment with the interior strip once glued.



4: Continue gluing the interior strip tabs.



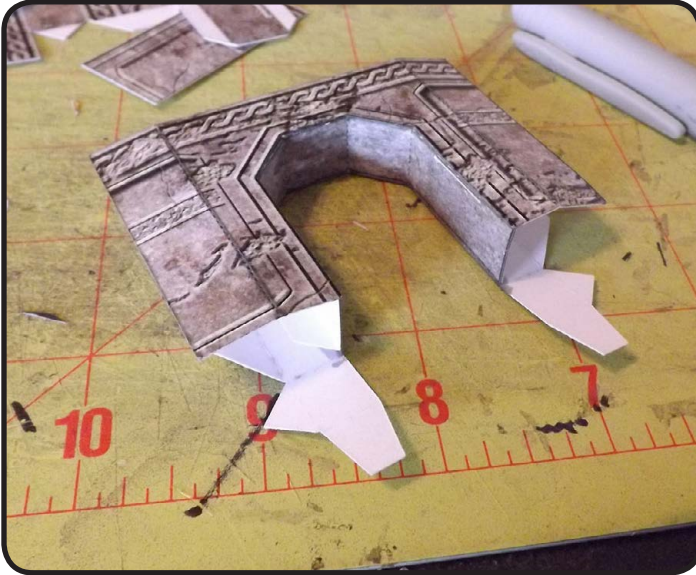
5: Finish gluing the interior strip to the inside face of the door opening.

Just a quick FYI folks; I always try to keep an eye out for new glues to use and found this at Wal Mart in the scrapbooking aisle. It dries almost as soon as you apply it. The bond is as tight or tighter than any other glue I use and it has an applicator tip that is TINY- perfect for small edges and flaps! GET SOME TODAY!

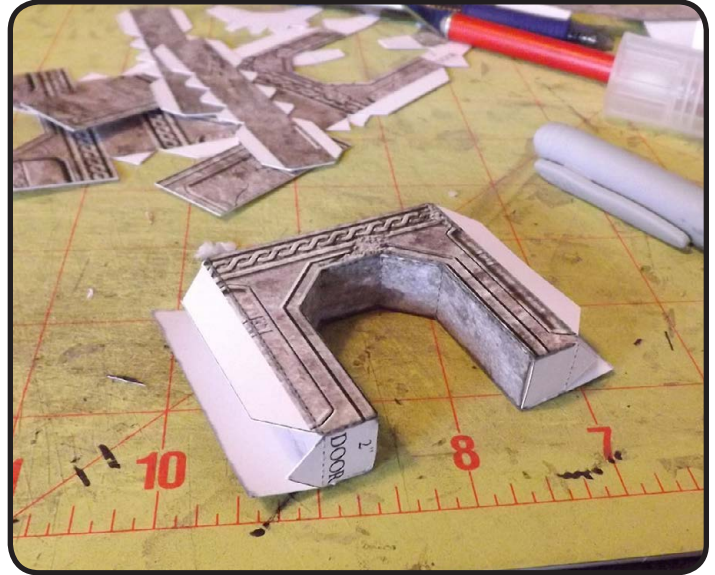




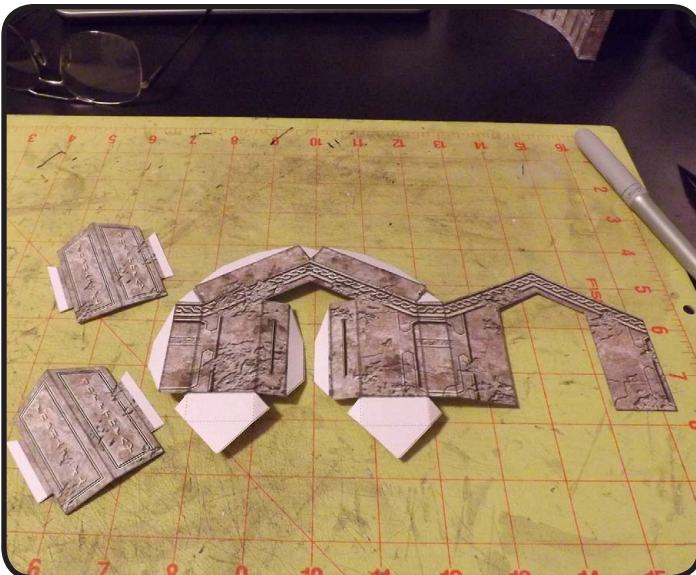

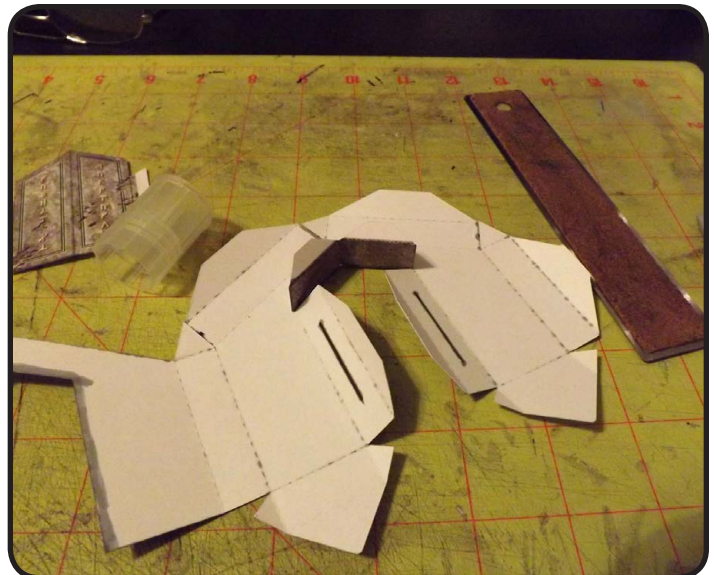
6: Fold the opposite wall face over and glue to the interior strip.



7: Next glue the bottom two flaps. Finish the model by gluing the side flaps into place. The doors can be inserted into the slot on the interior edge.



8: Cut and score the pieces for the large door.



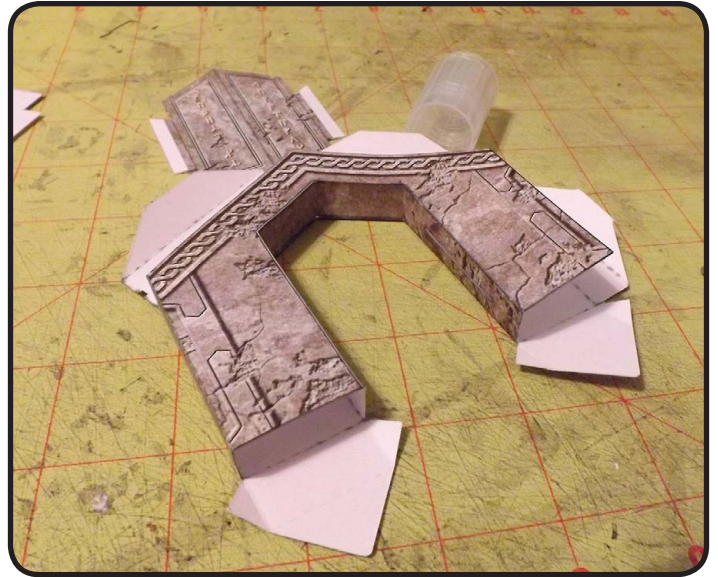
9: Begin by gluing the small top piece for the interior edge as depicted above.



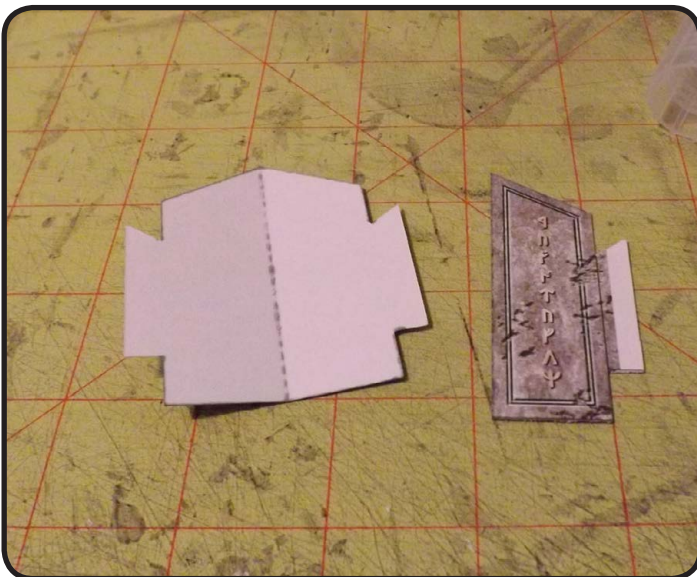

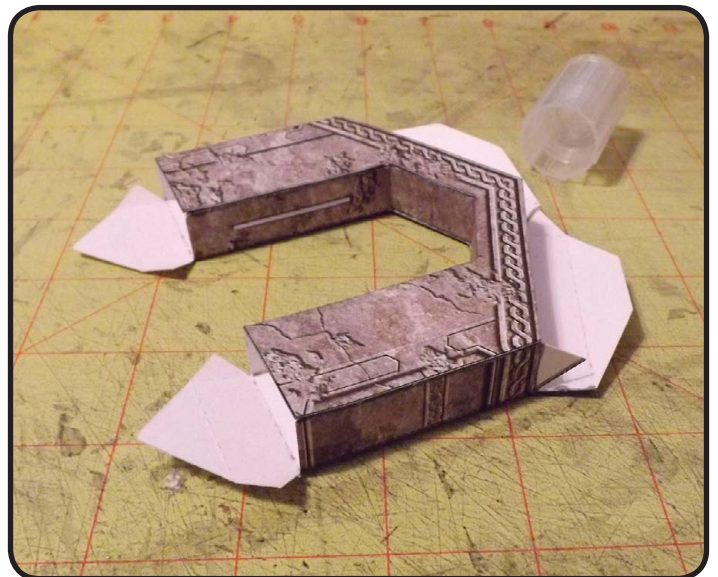
10: Fold the other side over and glue to the tabs in the upper interior edge peak.



11: Now glue the two side tabs of the interior edges to the front side face.



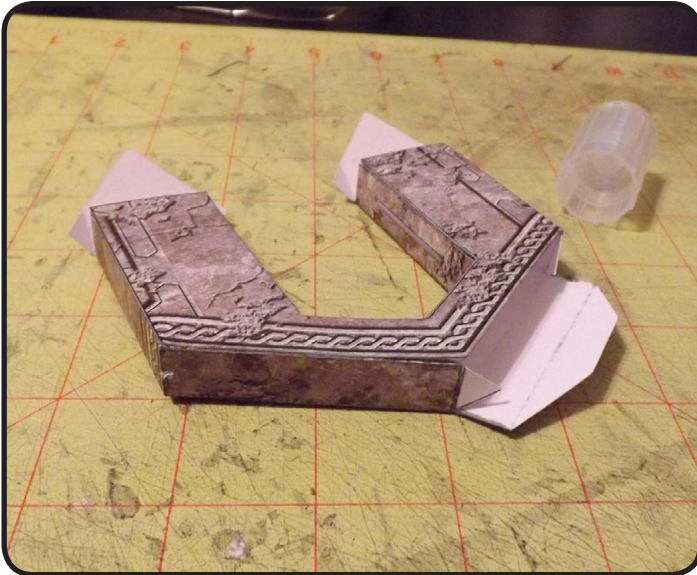
12: Fold the door pieces in half and glue.



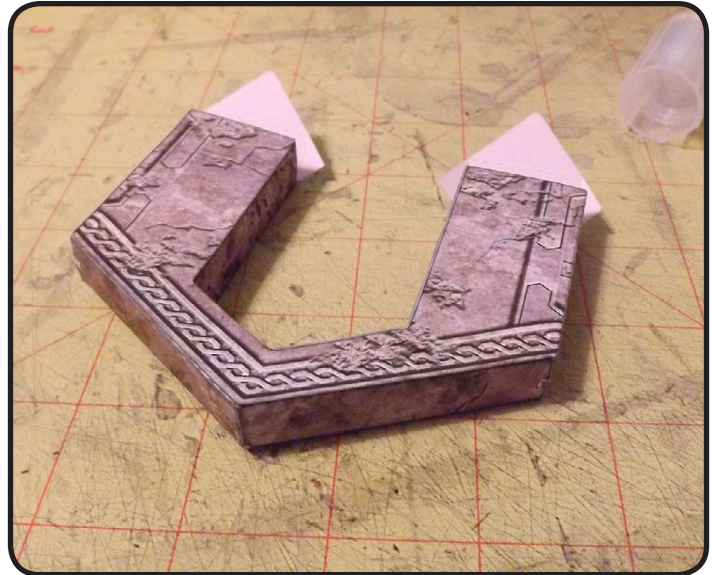
13: Glue the outer side flap in place.



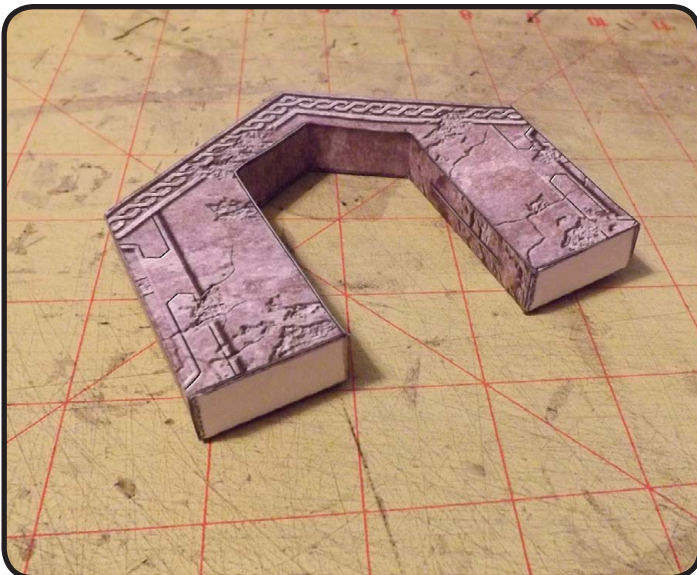

14: Glue the top flap that has the triangular tab at the peak first.



15: Next glue the remaining top flap into place.



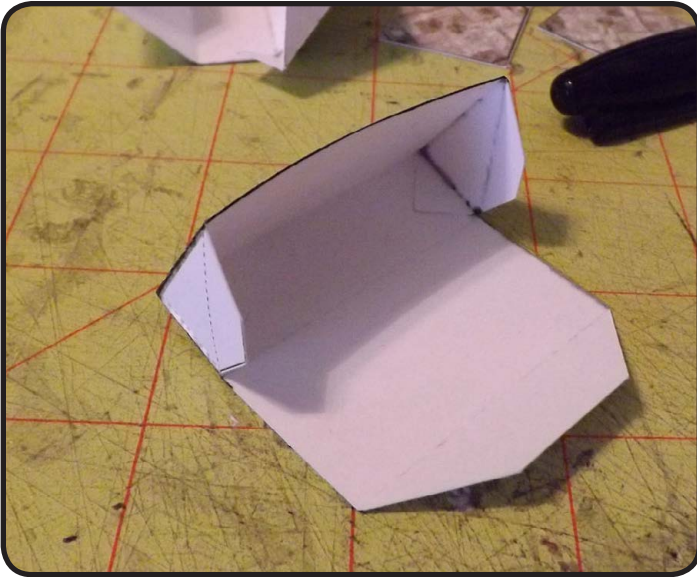
16: Finish by gluing the bottom two flaps into place.



17: The magical door model assembles similar to the previous model. Build the main wall in the same order (minus the interior sections, obviously.)



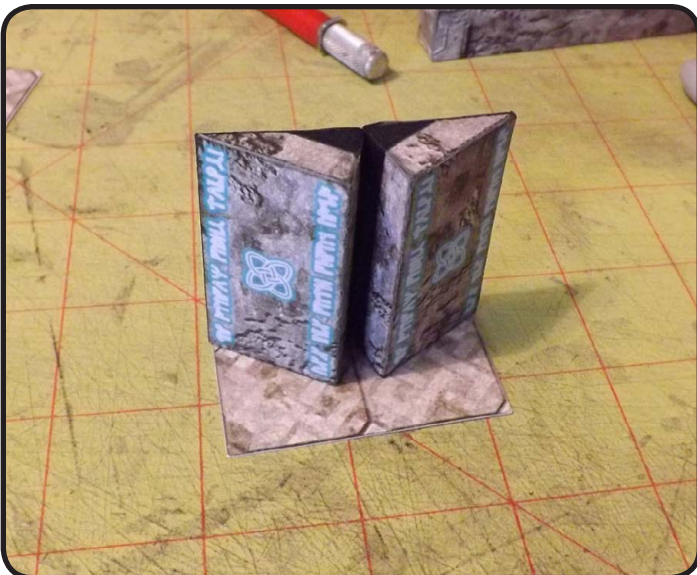

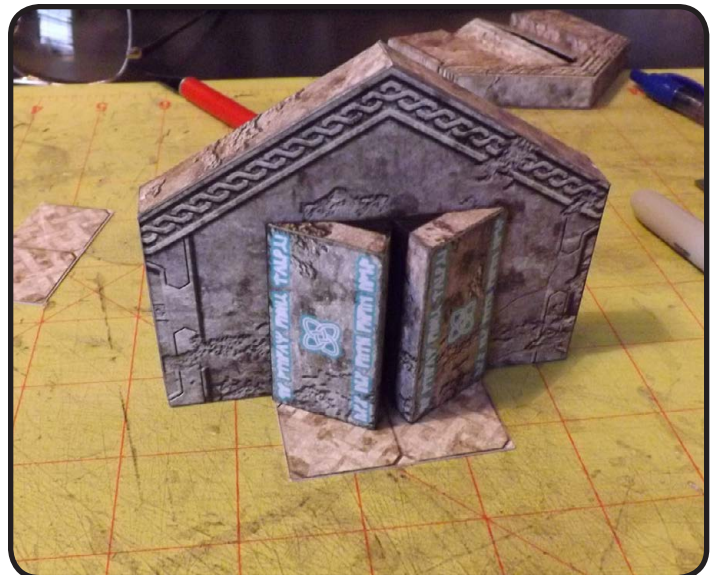
18: Begin the door models by gluing the upper and lower tabs.



19: Next glue the rear side into place. Repeat for the second door.



20: Glue the two doors to the floor piece.



21: DO NOT GLUE TO THE WALL, the door model can be placed next to the wall model once the players figure out how to open the door and taken away when it is shut.

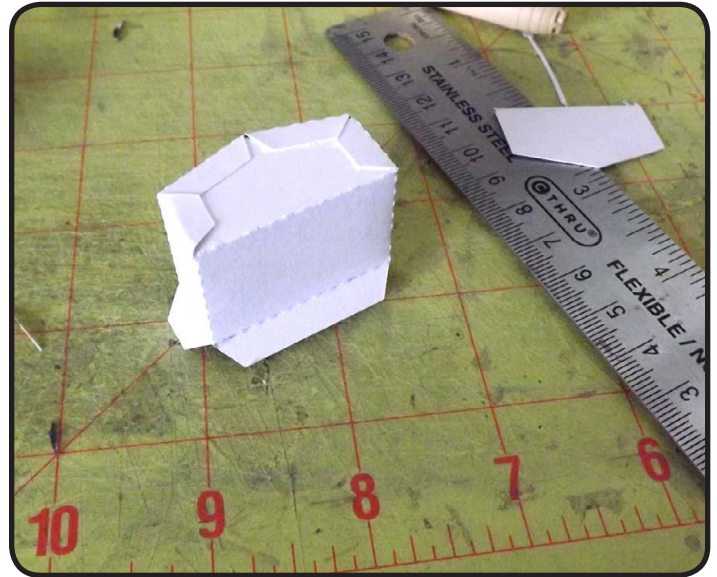

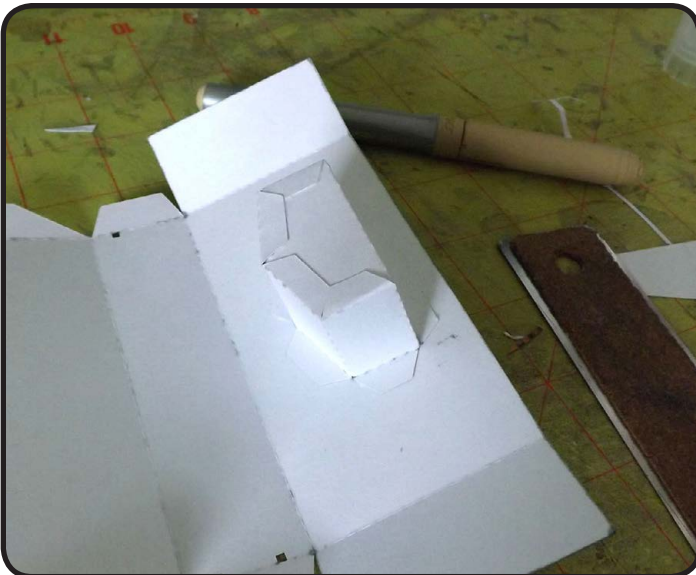
## CRYPT



1: Cut and score the crypt pieces.



2: Glue the interior alcove piece as depicted above.



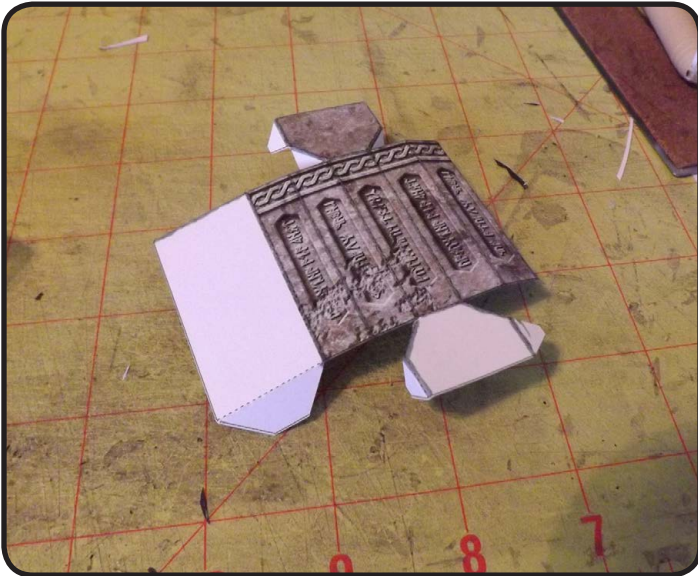
3: Glue the alcove to the inside of the main wall as shown.



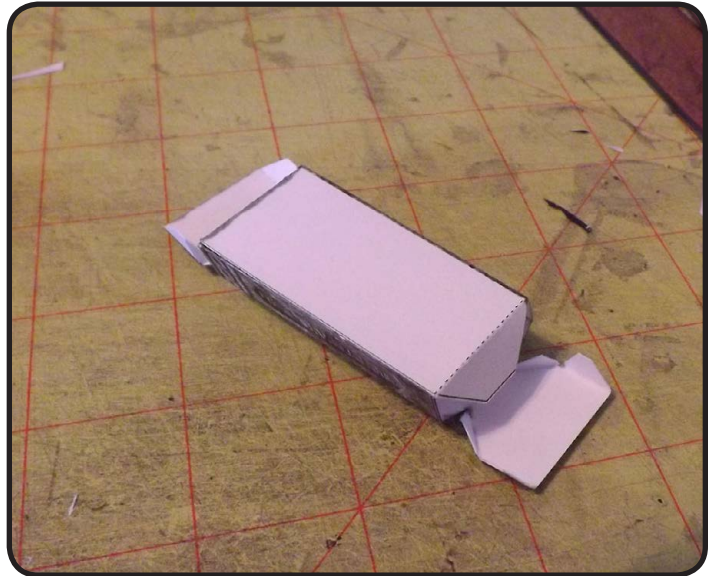
4: Fold the main wall as shown and glue the lower seam (don't forget to apply glue to the rear side of the alcove so it glues to the rear wall face as well.) Finish by gluing the side flaps.

5: Cut out the side pillar pieces.



6: Glue the long side tab.



7: Glue the top flap next. Finish the pillar by gluing the bottom flap.

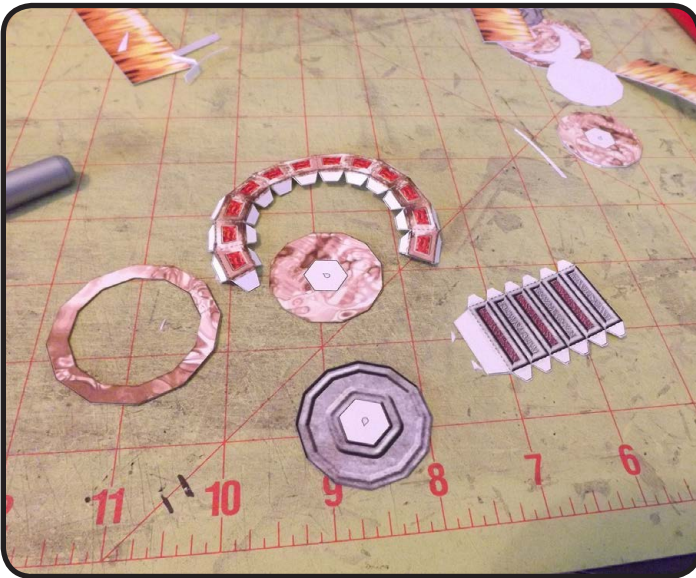


8: Glue the pillars to the sides of the crypt wall.

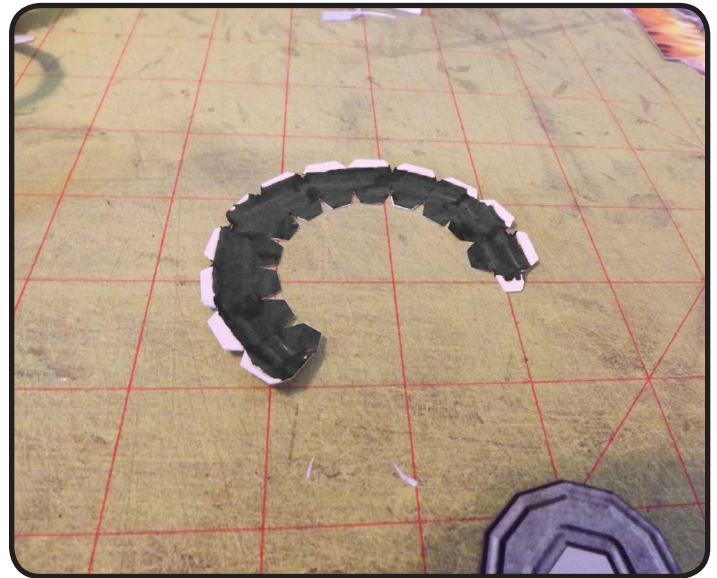


## DUNGEONS OF THE MOUNTAIN KING

### FIRE BRAZIER



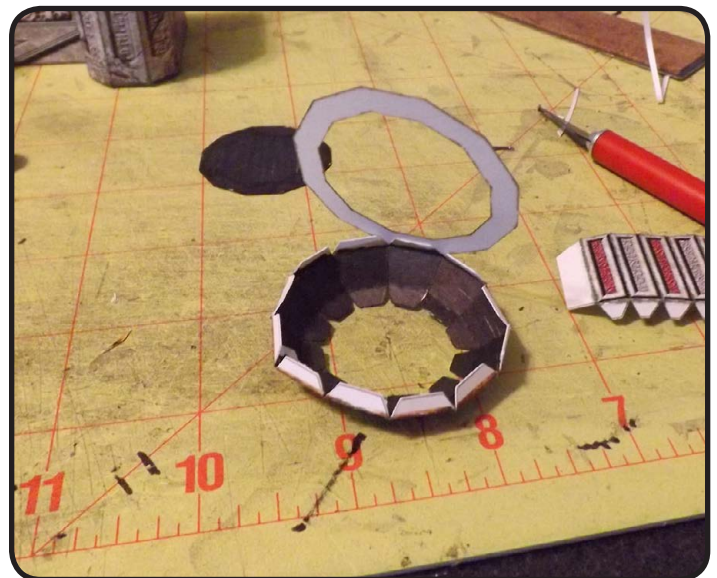
1: NO! NIET! I REFUSE TO TYPE IT!



2: Color the interior sides of the model with a dark gray or black marker. Move the marker quickly to prevent bleed through to the printed side (you can also use acrylic paint if you prefer.)



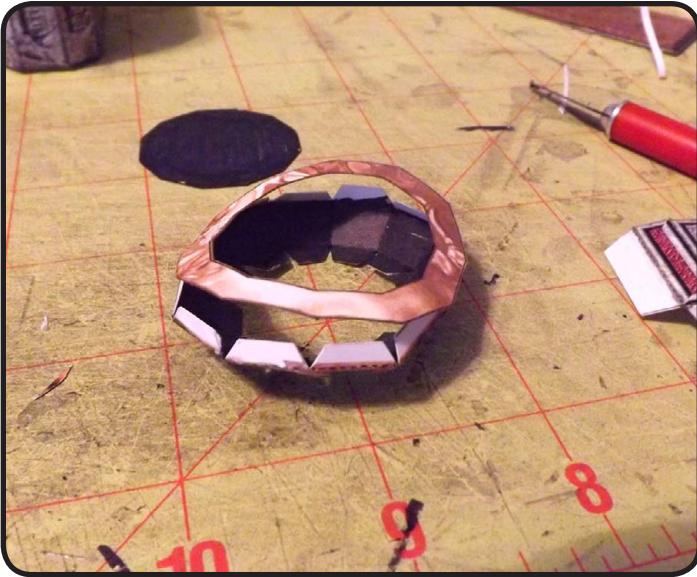
3: Glue the main strip into a ring.



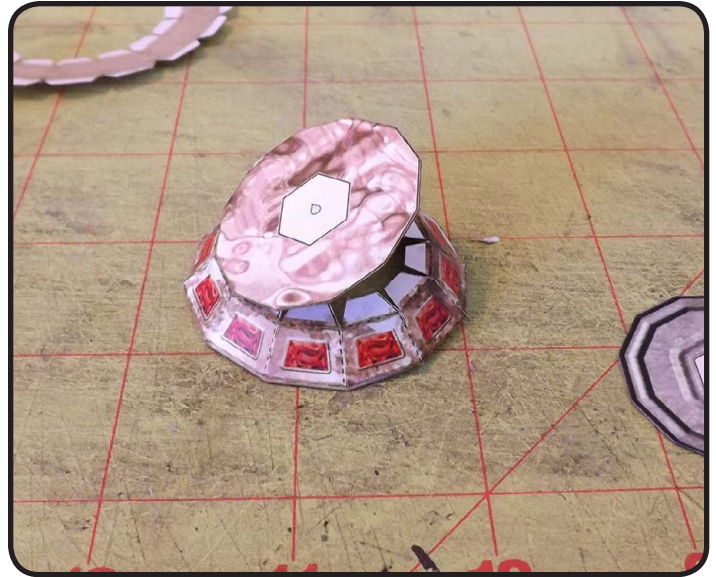
4: Glue the top flap to the main ring at a single tab.

5: Glue the tab on the opposite side of the one you just glued. Finish by gluing the remaining tabs.



6: Glue the bottom piece into place. We recommend you start with one tab, allow it to dry and then work from there.



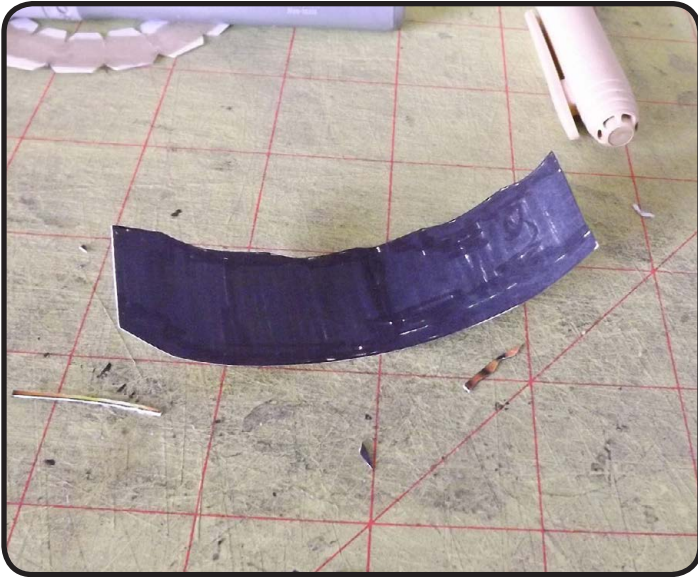
7: The finished pedestal.



8: The finished brazier glued to the pedestal.



## DUNGEONS OF THE MOUNTAIN KING



9: Color the interior of the fire piece black (or if you are really artistic use a mix of yellow and orange markers.) You can cut a wavy edge along the top for a more natural look.



10: Wrap into a tube and glue the ends.

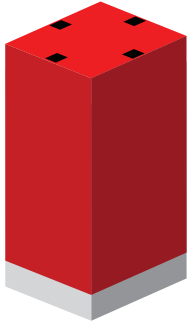


11: The finished brazier with fire model.

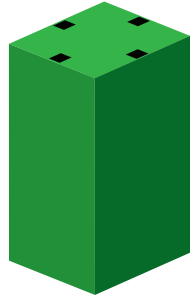


## E-Z LOCK PARTS

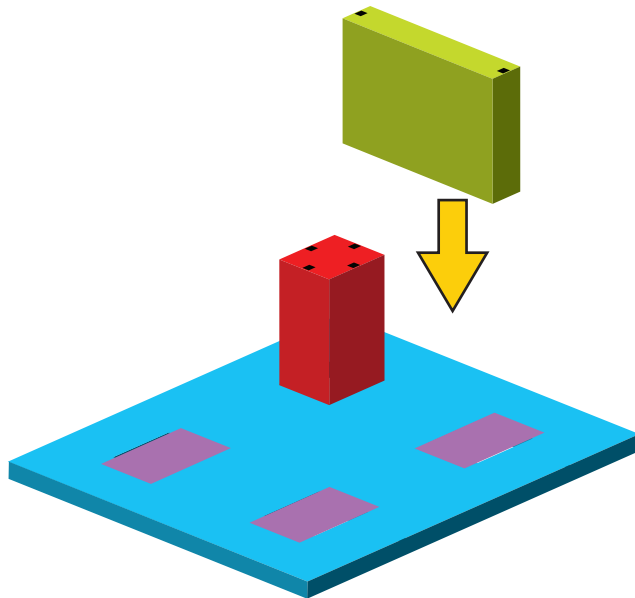
## DUNGEONS OF THE MOUNTAIN KING



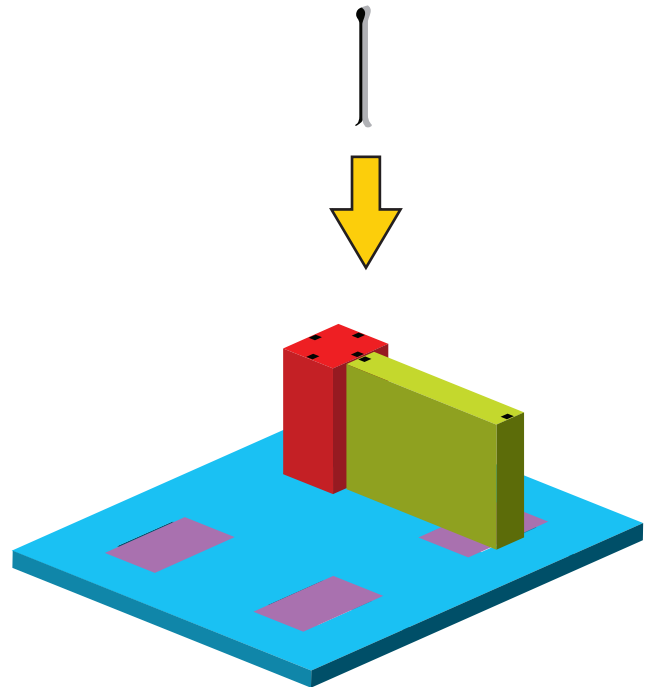
Use the cover pieces to hide the holes in your tile when not in use. Remove covers where you need to use an E-Z LOCK pillar (you only need one to anchor a large section.) Most dungeon layouts only use 2-3 as that is plenty to keep the layout bump proof.)



Insert the E-Z LOCK pillar as shown above.



Add a wall section next to your pillar.

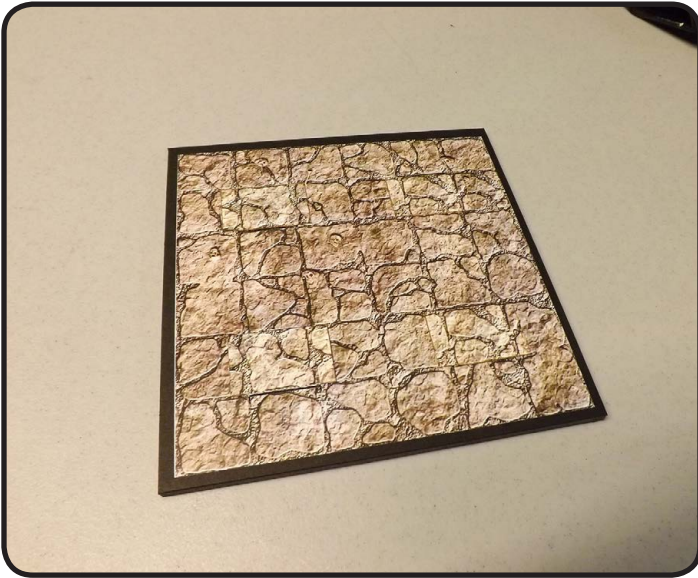


Use standard 2" bobby-pins or hairpins to lock the pieces together.

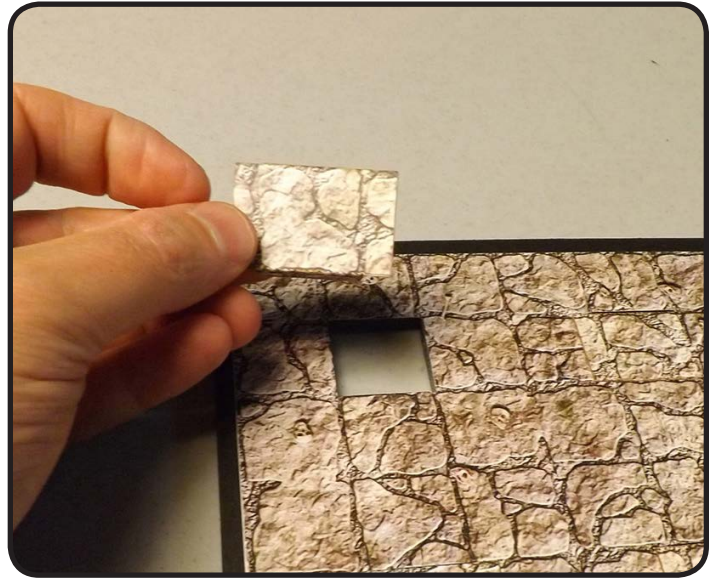


## Examples of E-Z LOCK construction

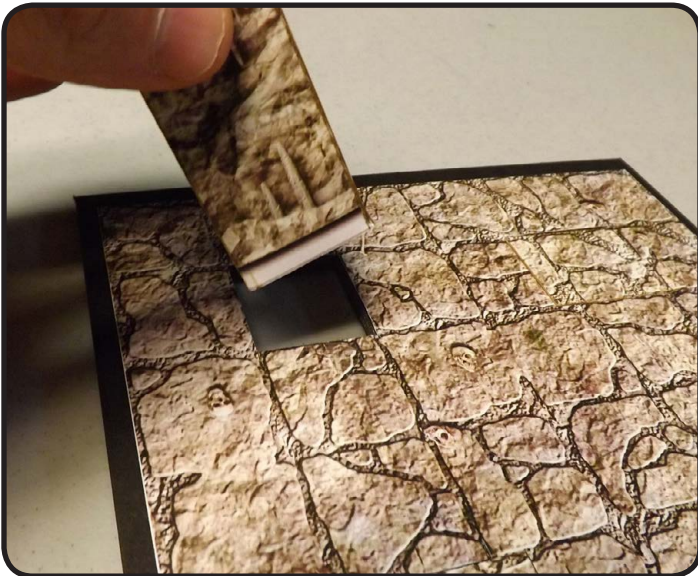
(Example pieces are from the Mines of the Mountain King terrain set.)



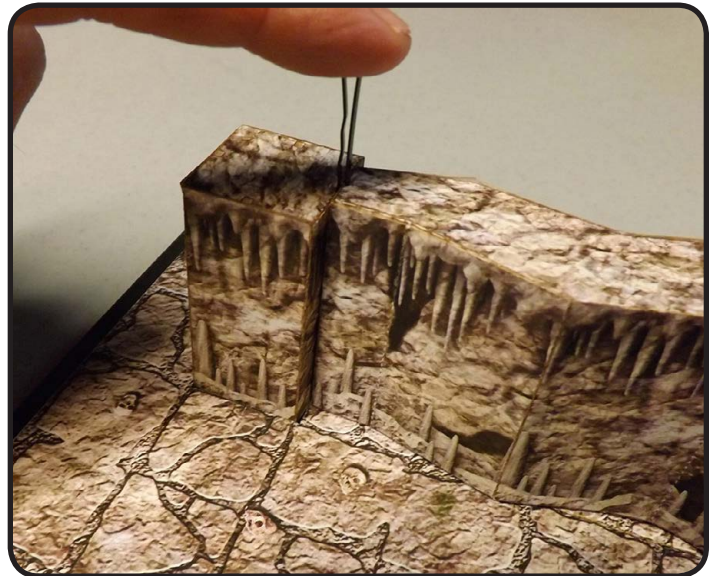
1: Sample tile with 1" squares cut out and covered with E-Z LOCK covers.



2: Remove cover.



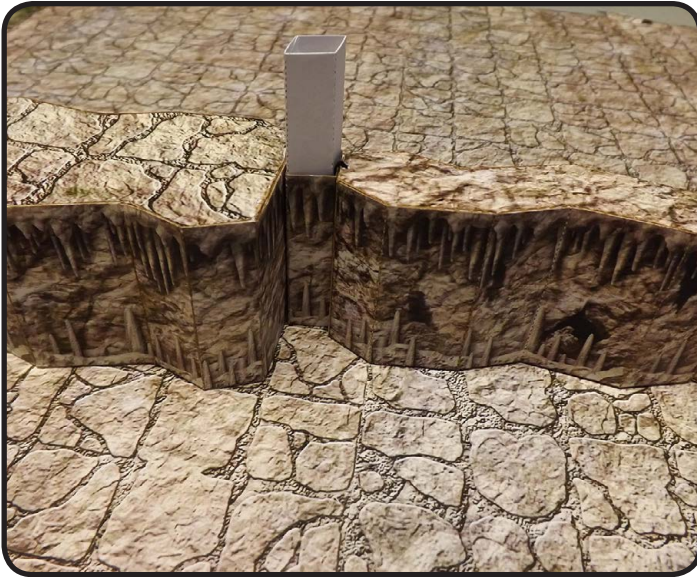
3: Insert a 1" E-Z LOCK pillar.



4: Begin linking walls to the E-Z LOCK pillar with bobbypins. You will only need a few E-Z LOCK pillars in a layout as they are simple for preventing lateral shifting during gameplay. Standard pillars can be used for most of the layout.



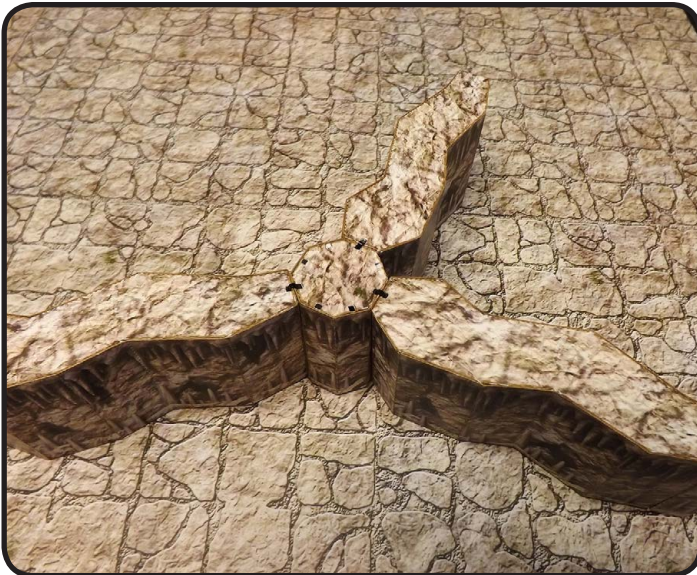
## DUNGEONS OF THE MOUNTAIN KING



5: For double-height builds, use a E-Z LOCK connector base plug in the 1" square hole in the tile, then insert an E-Z LOCK connector pillar. The first-level walls connect to the pillar with bobby pins. Then insert a connector link (white pillar) in the E-Z LOCK connector pillar as shown above.



6: Then add another connector over the link and begin bobby pinning walls to it.



7: The octagonal pillars can be used to attach walls at various angles for intersections and odd-shaped rooms.
