Before proceeding with this document, make sure you have read the beginners guide to card modeling included with this model set!

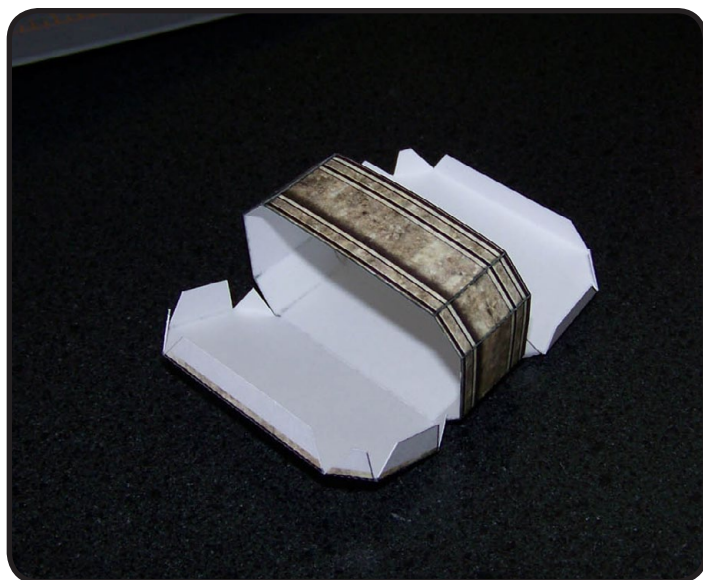
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Simple sarcophagus



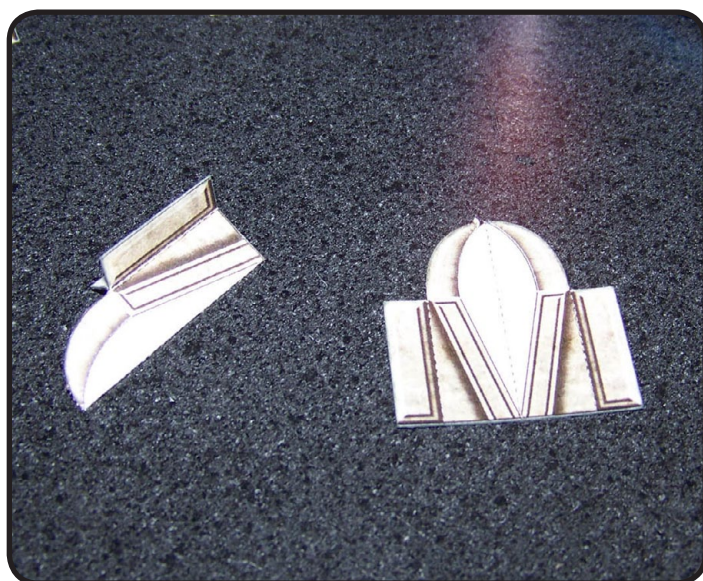
1: Cut, score and test fold the piece as shown.



2: Glue the side wall ends.

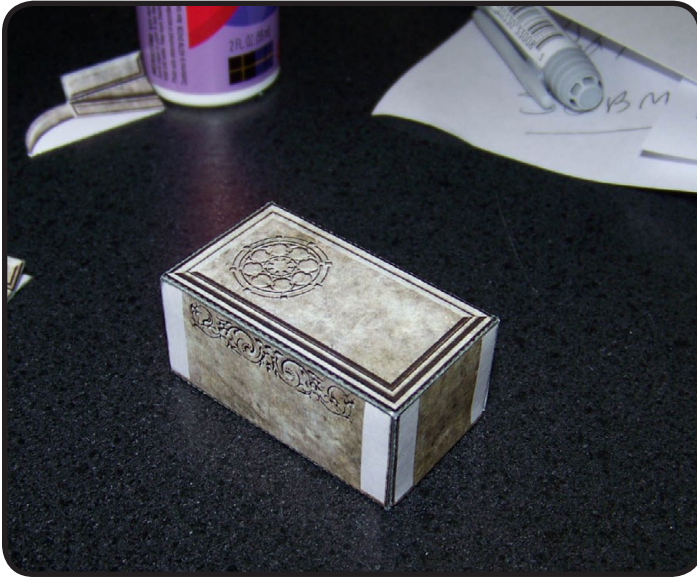


3: Turn upside down and place on your desk. Glue the top face into place. You do this upside down so you can make sure the piece glues flush with the top edge of the side walls for a perfect fit. Finish by gluing the bottom flap.



4: For the decorative ends or corners, simply fold and glue these in half, being careful if they have attachment tabs on the end (above) not to glue those. Cut away excess white areas when done.

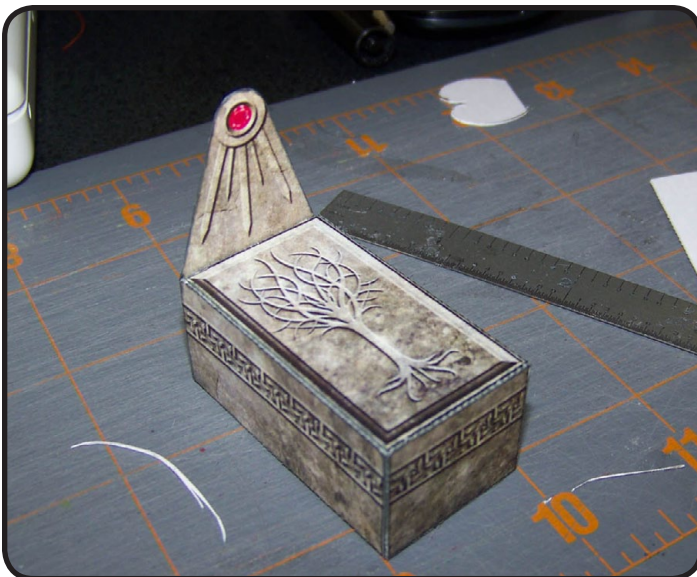
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5. Glue into simple box shapes per the Beginner's Guide instructions.



6: Glue any corners or head pieces to the finished box structure.



7: A sample sarcophagus with a head piece (several types included.)

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Opening Sarcophagus



1: Cut, score and test fold the lid piece.



2: Glue the four corners first.



3: Finish by gluing the bottom flap.

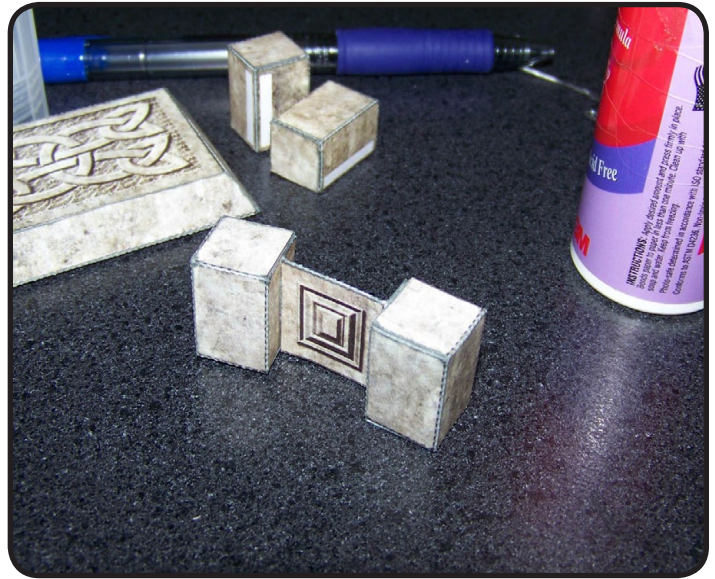


4: The corners of the main piece are simple box structures.

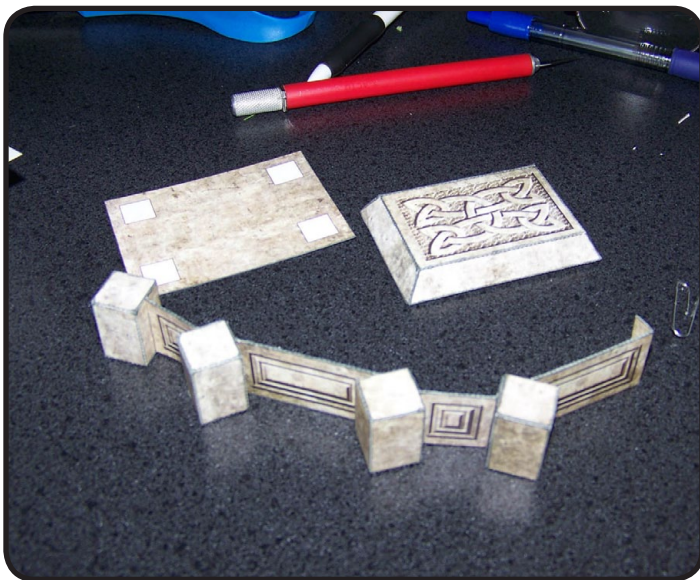
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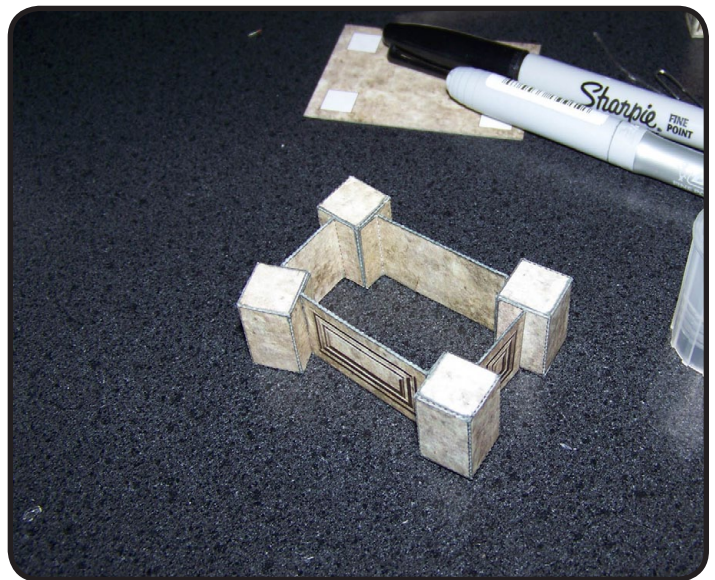
5: The four sides simple fold and glue in half as depicted above.



6: Each side wall glues to a corner box as shown.



7: Glue into a single long piece as shown.



8: Finish by gluing the ends together.

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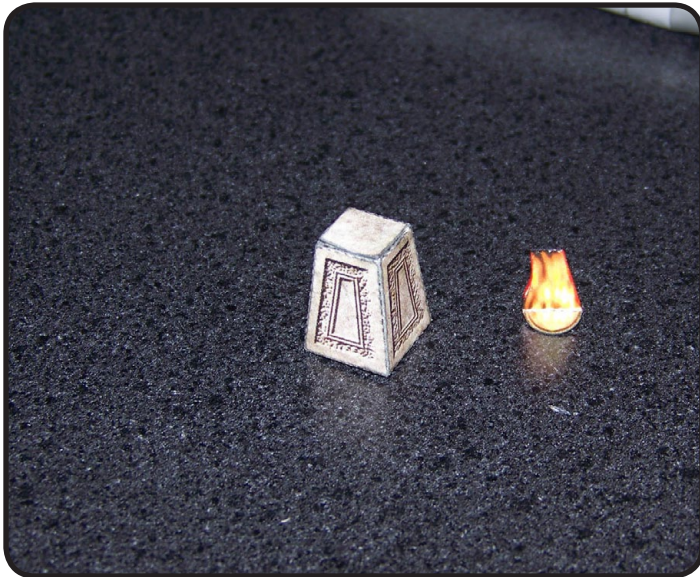
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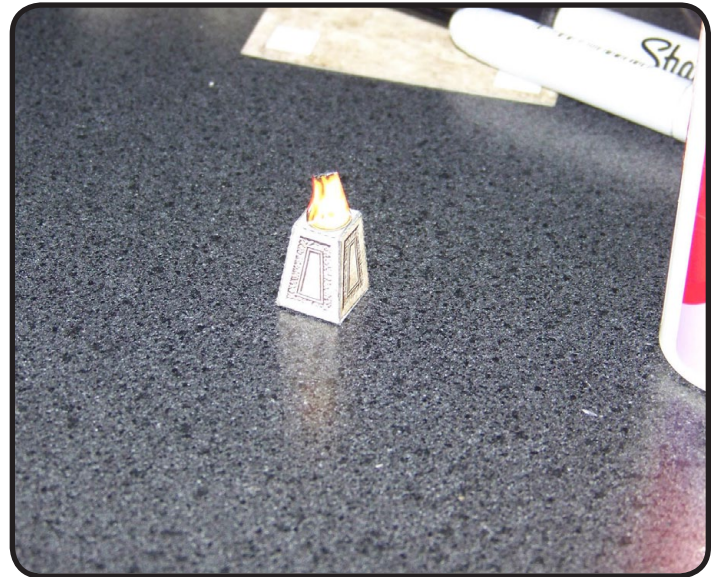
9: Glue the wall piece to the base section as depicted above.



10: Cut, score and test fold the flame pillars.



11: Fold and glue into box shapes as shown, the flame is a simple sandwich-fold assembly with the lower tabs folded outward.



12: Glue the two pieces together.
